



## **2021 VMX TALENT SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **DESCRIPTION**

Have a talent you want to share with your colleagues? Now's your chance. The Academy is accepting videos for the 2021 VMX Virtual Talent Show. By submitting your talent, you can earn points on the AAD Xtreme VMX leader board. At the close of the meeting the top point earners will receive prizes.

Submissions for the VMX Talent Show are being accepted from March 1, 2021 through April 9, 2021. Keep your video short, 1 minute or less.

### **WHO MAY ENTER**

All 2021 VMX registered attendees.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All videos must contain original content authored, composed, and performed by you, or a group. Only one video per registrant is allowed. Entries may include a wide range of talents, including but not limited to magic tricks, comedy sketches, dance routines, food and baking demonstrations, musical talents, gymnastics routine, juggling acts, singing, yo-yo tricks, skits and theater, and card tricks. Entries may not contain medical or cosmetic procedures; use of lasers; profanity; nudity; pornographic images; violent images; anti-competitive messages; illegal, offensive, or discriminatory material; material that violates the rights of third parties; or any other materials that is in violation of any federal, state, or local laws. You must also have permission to use any images, music, videos, or other materials or content in your video that you have not created yourself.

The Academy reserves total discretion to decide whether or not to include a video as part of its AAD VMX Talent Show. Participants will still receive their points towards the AAD Xtreme VMX leader board, even if their video is not part of the talent show.

Entering the talent show constitutes permission for AAD to use your video and caption in any manner it deems necessary or appropriate on its website, the VMX platform, or any other media and for any other purpose, without compensation and in perpetuity. By submitting any videos containing the names or images of any third parties, or other persons, you also represent and warrant that you have the consent of all such third parties to use their names and/or images. You also represent and warrant that your video will not otherwise infringe on the intellectual property rights of any third parties. You further agree to indemnify, defend, and hold AAD harmless from any third-party claims or damages arising out of any breach of the foregoing warranties.

## HOW TO ENTER

Tips to recording your talent:

- 1.) Ensure you have a working camera on your computer or phone to submit your talent video.
- 2.) Set your computer monitor to the highest resolution possible (1920x1080 or higher preferred, if possible). If recording on your phone, please ensure you are shooting in widescreen 16:9 mode.
- 3.) Before you begin recording, please make sure that while you are recording you are not competing for bandwidth with other household or office mates - they should suspend heavy bandwidth activities while you are recording. Additionally, find a quiet and well-lit place to do your pre-recording. Video's must not exceed 1 minute.
