

MIPS #110: Prevention Care and Screening: Influenza Immunization

Electronic health records (EHRs) collect and organize notes, medication lists, and patient information using various formats. With providers also documenting this information in unique ways, this can potentially cause confusion and an increased timeline for measure mapping with DataDerm. This tip sheet can help you manage reporting requirements for performance measures and streamline standard documentation practices to allow seamless data pull into DataDerm.

The DataDerm team will work with you to connect DataDerm with your EHR to extract data. To make the process as smooth as possible, it helps to document key elements of patient care. DataDerm cannot read scanned images of any kind, including scanned images for labs, letters to physicians, pathology reports, follow-up plans, and dates. If you have scanned images with information needed for your measures, please add a note in your chart with the date and required patient information for this data to be accurately collected.

This tip sheet can assist paper-based practices in standardizing documentation practices. Keeping notes in the patient's paper chart of all documentation requirements will assist you when reporting for this measure.

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For all patients 6 months and older, document the following in your notes:

- ☐ Qualifying encounters need to occur within the flu season that is being submitted:
 - If submitting between January 1, 2020 and March 31, 2020, quality data code G8482 should be submitted when the influenza immunization is administered to the patient during the months of August, September, October, November, and December of 2019 or January, February, March of 2020 for the flu season ending March 31, 2020.
 - If submitting this measure between October 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020, quality data code G8482 should be submitted when the influenza immunization is administered to the patient during the months of August, September, October, November, and December 2020 for the flu season ending March 31, 2021.
- ☐ Document patients who receive an influenza vaccination OR reported previous receipt of an influenza immunization.

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- ☐ If flu immunization did not occur OR patient did not indicate previous receipt, document clear reason if applicable:
 - ☐ Medical reason (e.g., patient allergy)
 - ☐ Patient reason (e.g., patient declined)
 - ☐ System reason (e.g., vaccination not available)
- ☐ This measure does not include the administration of the live attenuated influenza vaccines (LAIV).

Additional Tips:

- ☐ Previous receipt:
- ☐ Collect **once for visits for patients seen** during the performance period (each flu season, as applicable).
- ☐ For this measure, the live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV) and the intranasal flu vaccine are NOT options for numerator eligibility.
- ☐ See measure specifications for additional codes that can assist in seamless measure mapping from your EHR to DataDerm, if applicable (e.g. G8482).
- ☐ GQ, GT, 95, and POS 02 telehealth modifiers make cases ineligible.

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
