Safari Routing

Day	Itinerary
01	Transfer from Arusha area hotel to the meeting point. Depart Arusha in the afternoon and drive to Lake Manyara National Park for dinner and overnight.
02	Morning game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. Lunch at the lodge/camp and then drive to Serengeti National Park. Brief game drive en route to the lodge/camp.
03	Morning and afternoon game drives with meals at the lodge/camp.
04	Morning game drive as you head towards the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Picnic lunch and afternoon arrival at your lodge.
05	Crater tour with picnic lunch. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.
06	Drive to Arusha city centre arriving around noon.
