Quantity (qty) - Applies when there are multiple applications of a code

1. Skin tags: 35 removed = 11200 (15 lesions), 11201 + 2 qty (2x10 = 20 additional lesions)
2. Botox 20 units = J0585 + 20 qty
3. Triamcinolone: 2 ml of 10 mg/ml = J3301 + 2 qty (2x10 = 20 mg)
4. Actinic keratosis: N = number of AKs  
If N = 1, then only 17000  
If N <14, then 17000 for first lesion and 17003 + (N-1) qty  
If N ≥ 15, then only 17004
5. Biopsy: N = number of biopsies  
If N=1, then only 11100  
If N>1, then 11100 and 11101 + (N-1) qty
