The 2026 President's Gala, hosted in recognition of current Academy President Susan C. Taylor, MD, FAAD, is the American Academy of Dermatology's (AAD) premier philanthropic event, held during the AAD's Annual Meeting. This signature evening of community and philanthropy brings together more than 500 of the most influential leaders in dermatology including corporate partners, major donors, advocates, and Academy leadership—for a night of celebration, inspiration, and impact.

This year's Gala will honor Dr. Taylor and spotlight her future-focused vision to elevate the specialty by focusing on core pillars: Advocacy, Education, and Access to Dermatologist-Led Care. Central to Dr. Taylor's presidential theme is a commitment to supporting dermatologists so they may provide compassionate and quality care to all patients, ensuring that all patients, no matter their skin type or location, receive the expert care they need.

At the 2026 Gala, the AAD highlights vital programs that are transforming the future of dermatology and expanding access points to exceptional care from the experts:

- Expanding outreach, education, and access to care to set all kids up for a lifetime of healthy hair, skin, and nails. AAD community programs for youth open doors, particularly in communities that are traditionally underserved, with dermatologist-led education, resources, support, and care.
- Empowering dermatologists in their communities with AAD initiatives to provide high-quality care to all patient populations. By supporting dermatologists, residents, and future physicians, AAD access initiatives and education focus on reducing health disparities, advancing compassionate care, and meeting the needs of their patients and communities.
