Academy seeks statements on proposed bylaws amendment

Due Dec. 1

The American Academy of Dermatology is seeking statements regarding the proposed bylaws amendment that will be presented to the membership for a vote on the spring 2023 election ballot. Pursuant to the bylaws and administrative regulations for amendments, the ballot will be accompanied by up to three statements from eligible voting members who express support of and up to three statements in opposition to the proposed bylaws amendment. Members who wish to submit such a statement to the Secretary-Treasurer for consideration may do so via email at statements@aad.org.

Statements may not exceed the length of two typewritten, double-spaced pages. A statement may be submitted by one or more members, but no more than three members can be designated as principal authors and identified with the statement. The deadline for receipt of statements is **Dec. 1**.
