118 **CALL TO ORDER**

119 The meeting of the Advisory Board General Business Meeting of the American Academy of
120 Dermatology and AAD Association was called to order at 9:00 AM (CST) by Amy J. Derick, MD, FAAD,
121 Chair and presiding.

123 **QUORUM**

124 Dr. Derick indicated that a quorum was present.
125

126 **DISCLOSURE OF CONFLICTS OF INTEREST/CODE OF CONDUCT/ ANTI-TRUST COMPLIANCE**
127 **POLICY**

128 Prior to the meeting, all committee members received each other's written disclosure statements to
129 review and were directed to the AAD website to update their disclosure statements. Dr. Derick asked
130 members to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest with respect to specific agenda items.
131 The Academy's Anti-Trust Compliance Policy was also distributed in advance of the meeting.

133 **CCTF Meeting Recording Policy**

134 Dr. Derick reminded members of the CCTF Meeting Recording Policy. Per Academy Policy, the
135 recording of CCTF meetings is prohibited. Remember to remove any third-party screen and/or audio
136 recording applications before you join a meeting.

138 **Ground Rules Overview**

139 Dr. Derick provided an overview of the ground rules. The Advisory Board (AB) Executive Committee
140 holds an AB General Business Meeting at the AAD Annual and Innovation Academy meetings, for the
141 full body to vote on the Advisory Board elections and on proposed resolutions on matters of policy,
142 including, but not limited to, socioeconomic, political, and business policy of the Academy that were
143 presented at the Reference Committee Hearing. The full body can vote to adopt or adopt as amended.
144 Only Advisory Board Representatives of record are eligible to vote. The Advisory Board Chair presides
145 over the Hearing.

147 **NEW BUSINESS**

148 **Advocacy Strategies for State Medical Societies**

149 Erin O'Brien, Senior Vice President, State Legislative Affairs, Illinois State Medical Society gave a
150 presentation on advocacy strategies for State Medical Societies.
151

152 **Consideration of 2025 Resolutions**

153 Dr. Derick presented the Reference Committee recommendations for the 2025 resolution submitted for
154 consideration by the Advisory Board.
155

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156 The Reference Committee members convened immediately following the Reference Committee
157 Hearing on Thursday, July 10, 2025. The Reference Committee took into consideration the testimony
158 heard and provided the Advisory Board representatives with the Reference Committee Hearing Report
159 and its recommendation to adopt the resolution as amended.

160
161 The following resolution and recommendations were presented to the Advisory Board for approval on
162 the consent agenda:

163
164 AAD/A 001 – Advocating for Increases in AAD/A Resources Devoted to Achieve Reimbursement
165 Increases

166 Dr. Rachel L. Kylo, MD, FAAD extracted the resolution and proposed an amendment by substitution to
167 lines 31-34; “Therefore Be It Resolved, that the AAD will refrain from increasing Fellow membership
168 dues for a period of three years, unless a significant inflammatory update to the Medicare Physician
169 Fee Schedule is achieved”.

170
171 Dr. Kylo claimed that this amendment would send a stronger message to the Board of Directors. Dr.
172 Tope explained that the rationale of the edited resolved clauses; membership voted on the
173 Administrative Regulation – Dues Increase/Incremental Annual Adjustments/Special Assessments that
174 the Board of Directors can increase dues on an annual basis based on the cost-of-living adjustment.

175
176 Overall, the state societies were in support of the proposed amendment.

177
178 Dr. Roman Bronfenbrener, MD, FAAD, proposed an amendment by deletion to remove the phrase “...
179 baring the occurrence of unexpected exigencies.” in lines 36 and 37. Dr. Bronfenbrener argued that the
180 phrase was unnecessary because it is already understood that Board can do this. Dr. Tope explained
181 the rationale for this phrase; he explained that it was added to address that the Board of Directors may
182 have other things come up that would override the advocacy agenda.

183
184 A motion was made and duly seconded to adopt the resolution AAD/A 001 – Advocating for Increases
185 in AAD/A Resources Devoted to Achieve Reimbursement Increases as amended.

189 **USPSTF Skin Cancer Screening Controversy**

190 Rebecca Hartman, MD, MPH, FAAD, gave a presentation on USPSTF Skin Cancer Screening
191 Controversy. Dr. Derick provided an additional presentation on the Skin Cancer Screening Advocacy.

194 There being no further business, Amy J. Derick, MD, FAAD, Chair, thanked the committee for their
195 work and adjourned the meeting at 11AM (CST).
