Physician Level Learning Community Options

Physician Level: Unchanged Options

Attending a Live Learning Community Event: We will continue to host ~10 learning community events a year based on topics chosen by the collaborative and provide CME for attendance. Physician must be in attendance to earn credit, attendance from a non-physician does not meet this requirement.

View a Recorded Learning Community Event + Submit Quiz: Recorded versions of learning community events are available to be viewed on the admin portal, along with a brief quiz to demonstrate viewing. This option does not provide CME, but meets the learning community requirement.

Participate in CGM User Experience Program: Wearing a CGM and completing a testimonial will earn learning community credit. The testimonial must be submitted for credit to be granted.

Participate in Low Carbohydrate Diet Workshop: A beginner option will be offered each Spring and an advanced/specialist option each fall, with approximately 15 spots. Application required to join. Practice will also receive practice level credit for physician participation.

Physician Level: Removed Options

Reviewing Coverage Checker: We have gotten enough feedback on Coverage Checker and additional input is not necessary unless major changes are made to a future iteration.

Physician Level: Updated Options

Submit Feedback on a Physician Focused Tool: This option will still be available, but we will be narrowing the tools available for review to those that we are actively working on revising.

Participate in an MCT2D Site Visit: We will offer 7 site visits per VBR year, one in each region. Physicians in the practice **MUST** actively participate and attend a portion of the site visit in order to receive credit.

Physician Level: New Options

Participate in a feedback session on the MCT2D Admin Portal or MCT2D Website (20 sessions per year) : This option is available at a physician level and a practice level. If the participant is a physician, both practice and physician level credit will be earned.

Practice Level Learning Community Options



Practice Level: Unchanged Options

Participate in the Low Carb Diet Workshop: If anyone from the practice attends the beginner low carb workshop in May or the advanced/specialist low carb workshop in October, the practice will receive learning community credit. If the attendee is a physician, they will also receive physician level credit.

Participate in an MCT2D Focus Group: MCT2D will host quarterly focus groups on different topics such as the dashboard, the app, etc. Participation in one of these quarterly workgroup meets this requirement.

Participate in an MCT2D Feedback Session: There will be 20 feedback sessions offered over of the course of the VBR on either the portal or the website that a representative of the practice can attend for practice credit.

Access the MCT2D Patient Data Dashboards: Any practice that signs into the patient data dashboard twice over the performance year will receive practice level credit.

Participate in an MCT2D Site Visit: Practices that are chosen for one of the 7 annual site visits will receive practice level credit.

Practice Level: Removed Options

Share a dot phrase: We want to pause the dot phrase library submission collection and determine a way to share this information in a more user-friendly way than Airtable.

Participate in Health Advocacy Workgroup: We wanted to ensure that our workgroup participation credit was aligned across all our workgroups, and this was the only one we were giving credit for. Workgroup participation is now accounted for on the PO scorecard.

Provide feedback on a patient focused tool: The goal of this was to have a practice work with a patient to get patient feedback on a patient-focused tool but many practices did not partner with a patient and completed it independently.

Practice Level Updates Options

Complete an MCT2D Survey: We will be distributing a survey twice per year (Winter and early Summer) that physicians will have an option to complete. The survey will take no longer than 10-15 minutes to complete and topics will vary.

Revamping How Learning Community Information is Shared

2025-2026 PCP Scorecard

Consists of 4 measures:

- **Regional Meeting Attendance (25 points)**
- **Physician Level Learning Community Requirement (20 points-reduced by 5 to add survey)**
- **Practice Level Learning Community Requirement (25 points)**
- **A1c Control Measure (25 points)**
- **NEW ADDITION: Practice Demographics Survey (5 points)**

The uACR measure that practices are working on is not included because the scorecards are retrospective and reimbursement for that will not begin until 9/1/2027.

Practice Demographics Survey

- We will be asking each practice to complete a demographics survey between September- December.
- Survey is approximately 15 questions and asks questions regarding staffing (clinical pharmacist, nurse care manager, dietitian), insurance mix, EMR, and quality improvement resources

Purpose: Ensure that we have accurate, up-to-date information on practices to support work with the Michigan Value Collaborative for us to determine how we can best support practices based on their resources.
