### **Meetings**

- ***April PO calls are going to be canceled for MCT2D this month as a result of the regional meetings taking place. We will update the invites shortly.***

- ***Quarterly data reports will be distributed later this month, including updated A1C and BMI submission rates by PO.*** We are still evaluating if it makes sense to include these rates as part of the final PO scorecard, but wanted to provide them on an informational basis.
