Continuous Glucose Monitors Comparison












This comparison tool will help answer common questions to help make choosing one of the two most common brands of CGMs easier. **Contact your insurance provider to determine if a CGM is covered under your insurance plan and if your insurance has a preferred brand.**

Features	FreeStyle Libre 2/3 from Abbott 	G6 or G7 from Dexcom 
How long does a sensor last?	14 days, no grace period	G6: 10 day, no grace period G7: 10 day, +12 hours beyond expiration (grace period)
Is it compatible with iPhone and Android devices?	YES	YES
I don't have a smartphone, is there a reader I can use with the CGM?*	YES	YES
Is a separate transmitter required? If yes, how long does the transmitter last?	NO	G6: YES; 90 days G7: NO
What is the communication type (i.e. NFC, Bluetooth)?	Libre 2: NFC to start and scan the sensor, Bluetooth for alarms. Libre 3: NFC to start the sensor, Bluetooth for streaming glucose data and alarms	Bluetooth

*If you use a standalone receiver, you will need to upload your receiver to Libreview (FreeStyle Libre) or Clarity (Dexcom) before your doctor appointment, or bring it with you to your appointment if you do not have computer and internet access at home.

What is the size of the sensor?	Libre 2: 1.38in. wide x 0.20in. tall Libre 3: 0.83in. wide x 0.11in. tall	G6: 1.2in. wide x 1.8in. long G7: 1.07in. wide x 0.94in. long
Is the applicator pre-attached to sensor?	Libre 2: NO Libre 3: YES	G6 or G7: YES
Where on the body can the sensor be worn?	Back of upper arm	G6: Abdomen G7: Back of upper arm
What is the warm-up period (the period of time between applying the CGM and being able to read your glucose level)?	1 hour	G6: 2 hour G7: 30 min

What required alarms does the CGM have?	Urgent low alarm (<55mg/dL)	Urgent low alarm (<55mg/dL)
What optional alarms does the CGM have?	High glucose, low glucose, and signal loss alarms	High & low glucose alerts, predictive urgent low soon
Is calibration required?	NO	NO. Optional calibration is available.
Can I share my CGM data with my care team?	Via LibreView website	Via Clarity app and website
