Statin Survey

- Statin survey has been drafted, reviewed by the MCT2D patient advisory board, had their feedback incorporated, and has been sent for IRB review
- Requirement is that each practice has 5 patients who are not on a statin complete the survey
- MCT2D has created a flyer that practices can use to distribute the survey to patients. Patients will be compensated \$15 for completing the survey
- Survey will be available on September 1st and responses are due on December 15th
- We will have tracking on the Admin Portal available so you and your practices can see how many surveys have been submitted

Changes from Previous VBR Scorecard

1. **Regional Meetings:**
 1. *Previous Scorecard:* Both the spring and fall regional meeting were tracked together under one scorecard item.
 2. *Current Scorecard:* We have separated out attendance at the spring regional meeting and fall regional meeting into two separate measures. We made this change to make completion tracking clearer, as last year this caused confusion when one meeting had occurred and the other had not, and points were not yet assigned. This change should provide clarity.
2. **uACR Process Change Survey:**
 1. *Previous Scorecard:* Practices were asked to complete a census survey that provided information on the practice, including the EMR, patient insurance types, and clinical staffing.
 2. *Current Scorecard:* Practices will be asked to report the process changes they made to support increasing uACR testing, related to the performance metric. We plan to review which workflow and process changes are correlated with higher increases in performance.
3. **Patient Statin Surveys:**
 1. *Previous Scorecard:* N/A- no similar measure included.
 2. *Current Scorecard:* In lieu of a true performance measure on statins, we are asking practices to collect 5 survey responses from patients with type 2 diabetes who are not on a statin between September and mid-December in order to better understand patient barriers to statin use.
4. **Performance Measures:**
 1. *Previous Scorecard:* Included performance on the A1C control measure.
 2. *Current Scorecard:* Includes performance on the uACR screening measure, which launched on 7/1/2025 and ends on 8/31/2026. Scores will be available at the end of October and updated on the scorecard by the end of 2026. The next round of performance measures will begin on 1/1/2027 and conclude on 12/31/2027 and will not be included on the current scorecard.
5. **Deadlines for Completion for Physician Level Learning Community Requirement and Practice Level Learning Community Requirement:**
 1. *Previous Scorecard:* Due on 7/1.
 2. *Current Scorecard:* Due on 6/15. BCBSM has requested that we finalize the VBR scorecards earlier, which required us to move up the deadline by two weeks.

MCT2D Data Dashboard Updates

- MCT2D Patient Data Dashboard was updated on Wednesday, July 29th with data through 5/31/2026
 - Performance reports will be available shortly sharing the current rates.
- This brings data through the lock period for the PCP uACR measure, nephrology uACR measure, and endocrinology CGM interpretation measure, meaning that new patients cannot enter the denominator
- Next data updates will occur on 09/30/2026 (data through 07/31/2026) and then 10/30/2026 (data through 08/31/2026), the final data for the current performance measures

Data Challenges with the uACR Measure

- **Large increases in attributed patients throughout performance year**
 - One criteria for denominator inclusion: Patients who have at least one claim (for any service) since the beginning of the baseline period (01/01/2024) and the population lock date (05/31/2026) received by MCT2D (indicating that MCT2D is receiving claims for that patient)
 - This encompasses 2 years, 5 months by end date of measurement year

Future Plan: Evaluating what rolling inclusion criteria for claims looks like, so that we would have 12 months encompassed at any given time during the measurement period instead of 2.5 years, which should reduce number of patients captured

Patient Data Dashboard FAQ Document

- The Patient Data Dashboards and performance measures can be confusing
- We receive a lot of similar questions and to be as efficient as possible we have made a data FAQ document that we think will address the majority of questions
- We will plan to build on this as we receive more questions to make this as comprehensive as possible
- This will be posted on the Admin Portal under PO Resources

Questions Addressed in the FAQ

- What patients are included in the overall dashboard?
- How can I determine how a patient qualified for the MCT2D Patient Data Dashboard?
- Is the diabetes specific inclusion criteria for the current performance measures the same as the dashboard inclusion criteria?
- Is there a plan to make the performance measures diabetes specific inclusion criteria more restrictive?
- What about the current 2025-2026 uACR measure? My practice has a number of patients without T2D in their denominator.
- Why has my denominator increased so much since the start of the 2025-2026 performance measure period?
- Why are there deceased patients in my MCT2D Patient Data Dashboard list?
- Why are there duplicate patients in my MCT2D Patient Data Dashboard list?
- Where can I see which patients are included in my performance measures?
