Dan Dorner (1976, nationality: Dutch) is proposed for appointment as member of the Executive Board and Chief Commercial Officer Corporate Banking of ABN AMRO Bank N.V. subject to the approval of the European Central Bank.

Dan has over 23 years of experience in the financial sector and a proven track record in:

- leading high performing (large) teams in multicultural and diverse environments with global reach;
- building valuable client and product franchises across Corporate & Institutional Banking; Commercial & SME Banking and Retail & Preferred Banking;
- shaping solid organizational units, managing businesses and interacting with regulators and other stakeholders across both emerging markets and developed markets;
- managing risk within a three lines of defence model with relevant experience in Risk Management; and
- being a frontrunner and accelerator of transformational leadership, conduct and ethics, innovation, inclusion and diversity.

After graduating from university, Dan started his career at Alpha Bank Romania in the trade finance and credit departments. At the end of 1999, he joined ABN AMRO Bank N.V. where he fulfilled various roles. He started in Romania as a relationship manager corporate clients, and subsequently became a branch manager, a regional director and the head of branch network. In the latter role, he was responsible for regionalising the branch network in Romania and creating value for different client segments within both corporate and retail banking. In 2009, Dan joined ABN AMRO in the Netherlands in the loan syndication team. Soon thereafter, he was appointed as head of Origination, Loan Syndications. In July of 2013, he became Global Head of Loans & Debt Capital Markets and joined the global management team of Debt Solutions. He was responsible for building related product capabilities in the area of origination, structuring and distribution of complex financing transactions in Amsterdam and in the Debt Solutions international network (New York, Singapore, Sao Paolo).

In December 2015, Dan joined the Financial Restructuring & Recovery unit of ABN AMRO firstly in relation to the Corporate & Institutional Banking portfolio and later as Global Head for the entire non-performing client portfolio. As Global Head Financial Restructuring & Recovery he reported to the Chief Risk Officer and had ExCo-1 responsibility for the financial restructuring and recovery/insolvency activities of ABN AMRO Bank N.V. He also was part of the management team of Risk Management and led a team of more than 175 professionals.

Between April 2019 and August 2020, Dan led the Structured Finance, Lending and Portfolio Management activities and was part of the management team of Corporate & Institutional Banking. In September 2020, Dan was appointed as Senior Managing Director, Head of Corporate & Institutional Banking Non-Core Unit. In this role he is responsible for the wind down of ABN AMRO's non-core activities including Global Trade & Commodities Finance, all corporate banking sectors in the APAC region, US and Brazil. In addition, the CEO of Corporate & Institutional Banking has announced that he will pursue his career outside ABN AMRO and Dan has taken over his responsibilities as of 12 October 2021 on an interim basis to ensure a smooth transition.
