It is proposed that Wouter Devriendt will be appointed as a member of the Supervisory Board of ABN AMRO Bank N.V., subject to the approval of the European Central Bank

Wouter Devriendt is a Belgian national. He started his career at ABN AMRO, where he worked in different national and international roles, predominantly within the wholesale and corporate bank. Between 2005 and 2008 he worked for Fortis (Brussels and Amsterdam) and co-managed the integration of ABN AMRO into the Fortis group.

Upon his departure from Fortis in 2008, Wouter has been advising the Belgian government on the restructuring of the Financial Services sector. From 2012 to 2016, he was a member of the Board of Directors of Belfius and from 2013 to 2016, he was also Chairman of the Board of Directors of Amsterdam Trade Bank. From 2014 to 2016, he was a member of the General Council of the Hellenic Financial Stability Fund which aims to contribute to the stability of the Greek banking system. In early 2016, he was appointed to lead residual bank Dexia. From 2016 - 2019, he was Chief Executive Officer and member of the Board of Directors of Dexia (Brussels) and of Dexia Crédit Local (Paris). Between January 2020 and May 2021, he worked at UniCredit as SEVP of Finance & Controls of UniCredit Group.
