Tanja Cuppen was appointed to the Executive Board of ABN AMRO Bank N.V. effective 1 October 2017 and reappointed effective 21 April 2021 for a period of three years. As Chief Risk Officer (CRO) she is responsible for Risk Management and Compliance. Her term of appointment expired upon the closing of the annual general meeting on 24 April 2024.

Tanja began her career in 1994 at Rabobank where she had various roles before she became Global Head of Corporate Finance in 2007. In that position she was responsible for amongst others Acquisition Finance, Renewable Energy & Infrastructure Finance and Client Solutions.

In 2013 she assumed the role of Chief Financial & Risk Officer at Rabobank International. Tanja was appointed Chief Risk Officer at Rabobank North America in 2014. Her responsibilities included establishing a regional head office in the US, leading a regulatory change program, establishing an enterprise wide risk management function and overseeing Rabobank's activities in North America.

In addition, Tanja was Commissioner of the Financial Sector Commission on Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking.
