## **ABN AMRO Clearing updates the Reporting Wizard Portal**

From 31st March 2019, the Reporting Wizard Portal will be upgraded. The new Reporting Wizard Portal includes new features such as:

- Scheduling Reports
- Creating your own reports (custom filters, sorts, column selections)
- View Pending Settlements and Positions in real-time
- Personalized dashboard which gives you a quick overview of your data
- The option to view your Pending Settlements on instruction level

#### Wizard

This user-friendly Wizard allows to clients to create, save and schedule reports. Reports can include both real-time data and a lookback function of up to 45 days:

Next to the Reporting Wizard Portal, ABN AMRO Clearing provides its clients with access to the Archive.

#### Archive

Having access to a reporting archive, to view previous sent reports is vital for any modern business. The Archive application allows clients to access their daily, monthly and intraday historical data. The intuitive interface enables clients to download reports any time. The Archive also limits the need for regular email traffic. For example: instead of receiving intraday position emails every 15 minutes, clients can now download these records from the Archive when needed. The Archive retains 13 months of historic data.

#### ICE-ENDEX will add new gas futures contracts

From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2019, ICE-ENDEX will start offering Austrian CEGH VTP and French PEG Gas Futures contracts, subject to completion of relevant regulatory processes.

The futures contracts are for physical delivery in the respective market zones CEGH – virtual trading point and Trading Region France (TRF).

The contracts consist of Physical Futures up to:

- 59 consecutive month contracts
- 7 consecutive quarter contracts
- 7 consecutive season contracts
- 4 consecutive year contracts

Months, quarters, seasons and years are listed in parallel. The contracts are in Euros.

#### Liquefied Natural Gas Futures will be added to PEGAS

In the Energy Products Newsletter circulated in December 2018, we informed you about the launch of Liquefied Natural Gas Futures (based on Platts Japan Korea Marker (JKM) to PEGAS. The launch was initially planned for 19<sup>th</sup> February 2019, but it is now delayed until the 21<sup>st</sup> May 2019.

These new products will be available via STP trade registration (Trayport Clearing Link and EQUIAS eXRP) at Powernext/PEGAS and subsequent clearing by ECC.

### Spanish gas contracts will be added to PEGAS

In the Energy Products Newsletter circulated in December 2018, we informed you about the launch of gas contracts on the Spanish PVB (Punto Virtual de Balance). It is expected that these products will be added in May 2019.

The contracts consist of Physical Spot and Futures up to 6 years ahead. The geographical spreads will be PVB/TFF and PVB/PEGN. ABN AMRO Clearing fully supports these new products and are able to clear these from launch date.
