Jean-Pierre Mustier was appointed to the Supervisory Board of ABN AMRO Bank N.V. on 22 April 2026 for a period of four years. His current term of appointment will expire upon the closing of the annual general meeting in 2030.

Jean-Pierre began his career at Société Générale in 1987, where he held progressively senior roles until 2009, including Head of Corporate & Investment Banking, and later overseeing Asset Management, Private Banking and Securities Services. In 2011 he joined UniCredit as Deputy General Manager, responsible for the Corporate & Investment Banking Division. In early 2015, Jean-Pierre became a London-based partner at Tikehau Capital, an alternative investment management group. He returned to UniCredit in mid-2016 as CEO, a position he held until 2021. During this time, he served as Chair of the European Banking Federation from 2019 to 2021.

From 2021 to 2023, Jean-Pierre sponsored three special purpose acquisition companies (Pegasus Europe Acquisition Company B.V., Pegasus Entrepreneurial Acquisition Company Europe B.V., and Pegasus Asia). In 2023, he joined the Supervisory Board of Aareal Bank AG, a German commercial real estate-focused bank, and became Chair in early 2024. He also joined the Board of Atos SE, a French technology company, as Chair and later Chair and CEO. He left the Atos' Board and CEO's position on 31 January 2025, upon completion of the company's restructuring and the appointment of his successor. As of 2025, he is member of the Supervisory Board of the Deutsche Börse AG. Furthermore, he is a member of the advisory boards of Revaia and the Banking Circle Group, as well as advisor (*censeur*) to the board of directors of Qonto S.A.
