ICE-ENDEX is planning to extend its Gas offering as per Monday 2 December 2019 with the Austrian CEGH VTP Natural Gas Daily Futures contract. This is subject to completion of relevant regulatory processes.

Trading participants with user permissions for the existing Dutch TTF Gas Futures will be able to access the new contract from the start.

# Short term EEX Austrian power futures and new maturities for Italian, French and Spanish Power

From 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2019, additional products will be added to the EEX trading platform. New short term future contracts for the Austrian market area (EEX Phelix-AT Futures) and the extension of quarterly maturities for Italian, French and Spanish power futures.

All products are settled financially in EUR. These contracts have to be reported according to EMIR article 9.

## **EPEX Spot is expanding in the Nordic Markets**

In the September 2019 Energy Newsletter, we announced that ECC and EPEX Spot are planning to expand Day-Ahead Auction and Intraday Continuous products on the Danish, Finnish, Norwegian and Swedish markets. EPEX Spot will extend its trading offer to new market areas in the framework of the Guideline on Capacity Allocation and Congestion Management (CACM), which enables power exchanges to operate markets outside of their historical home markets.

To date we have been informed about the following time-lines:

- For intraday continuous products, expected go-live in January 2020, between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> calendar week
- For day ahead auction products, expected go-live in March 2020

Financial settlement will be performed in Euro currency for all contracts on all spot markets. The new products will be included in the respective financial trading limits for Day-Ahead Auction trading and Intraday Continuous trading.
