Sustainable Farming Internship Assignment Possibilities:

- **Integrated pest management.**
- **Environmental study amphibians compare on farm area**
- **Comparison of soil mulches on soil moisture and weed suppression.**
- **Pollinators diversity in regenerative systems vs conventional farms.**
- **Evaluations of fermented botanical pesticides, fungicides and nutrient amendments.**
- **Carbon sequestration potential of current and proposed PPBC agroforestry species.**
- **Pest incidents and natural enemy abundance.**

- **Soil microbial biomass and carbon under regenerative vs conventional farming plots.**
- **Cost analysis of regenerative vs conventional farming systems.**
- **Use of perennial peanut as a cover crop, it's use as weed suppression and effects on the nitrogen cycle.**
- **Ground water analysis to assess the presence or absence of agrochemicals in the wells**
- **Available nitrogen sources suitable for organic farming. Test and analysis of currently used soil/nutrient amendments and how to encourage nitrogen availability.**
- **Tree planting program; survey the trees within Cikananga then using grafting techniques propagate the trees that are useful for us in the tree nursery.**
