Brief Information About the Activity

Topic/Subject of the Activity	Special Lecture on the Principle of Secularism in the Constitution of India
Objectives	To impart student the fundamental knowledge of the concept of secularism
Outcomes	To create awareness among students regarding the concept of secularism and resolve the misunderstanding regarding the concept.

Details of the activity:

On date 30th August 2023 a special lecture on the "Principle of Secularism in the Indian Constitution" was arranged by Social Science Forum and the Department of Political Science jointly. Adv. N. L. Jadhav, President of the Aurangabad High Court Lawyers Association, was guest speaker.


While delivering the lecture, Adv. Jadhav elaborated on the true nature of 'Secularism' in the Indian Constitution. He emphasized that India's Constitution is fundamentally secular which is characterized by a positive form of secularism unlike that in Western countries. This means that all religions hold equal importance in India, and the state cannot discriminate in favor of or against any particular religion. Every citizen has the freedom to practice their religion, and it is the state's responsibility to ensure harmony among all religions. If a religious practice or any person or a group of persons disrupts society, the state has the authority to regulate it. Adv. Jadhav convinced his argument by giving various examples, underlining that India's Constitution is a global ideal and the principle of Secularism is a foundational principle of it. He urged students to understand that the survival of secularism is essential for India's unity and integrity and the survival of the democracy.

In the introductory remarks, Professor Dr. Rajendra Shejul, convener of The Social Science Forum and head of the Department of Political Science, highlighted the lecture's purpose. The program concluded with remarks from Vice Principal Dr. T. R. Patil, and it was presided over by College Principal Dr. D. R. Shengule. Dr. Datta Lavand anchored the program.

The event was attended by members of the forum including Dr. A. R. Wagdao, Dr. S. K. Phole, Dr. G. M. Gangurde, and Dr. D. B. Solunke, as well as a significant number of students and faculty members.




