CODE OF ETHICS

To Check Malpractices and Plagiarism in Research

In order to put check on plagiarism and to eliminate scope of this menace in higher education System College has very much concern to address any issues—related to plagiarism by students and faculty. In case of any lapses the College will initiate an action as per the UGC regulation 'UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (PROMOTION OF ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND PREVENTION OF PLAGIARISM IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS) REGULATIONS, 2018'.

The College has instructed all faculty members that before submitting their Dissertations/Thesis / research papers/ articles to any University, Journals they should check their written material for plagiarism if any through the anti plagiarism software www.urkund.com provided by the University/College and take necessary preventive steps if any. The userId and password was issued to each faculty by the Office of College Librarian.

It is the College policy that:

- a) College shall implement the technology based mechanism using appropriate software so as to ensure that documents such as thesis, dissertation, publications or any other such documents are free of plagiarism at the time of their submission.
- b) The antiplagiarism tools shall be made accessible to all engaged in research work including student, faculty, researcher and staff etc.
- c) Every student submitting a thesis, dissertation, or any other such documents to the College/University shall submit an undertaking indicating that the document has been prepared by him or her and that the document is his/her original work and free of any plagiarism.
- d) The undertaking shall include the fact that the document has been duly checked through a Plagiarism detection tool approved by the College.
- f) Each supervisor shall submit a certificate indicating that the work done by the researcher under him / her is plagiarism free.
- g) The researcher shall submit to INFLIBNET soft copies of all Masters, Research program's dissertations and thesis within a month after the award of degrees for hosting in the digital repository under the "Shodh Ganga e-repository".

This is instructed to all faculty members to strictly comply with these code of ethics for themselves and students.
