TORONTO – TIFF announced today TIFF Industry Selects, a curated selection of 30 global films beyond the Official Selection that are available for sale at this year’s Festival. These titles, hand selected by TIFF’s Industry and Festival Programming teams, are sure to garner interest from buyers, as they reflect the Festival’s global spirit and showcase a host of new voices and international talent. These films will be presented on the festival’s dedicated platform for press & industry, TIFF Digital Cinema Pro, to accredited press and industry throughout the 45th Toronto International Film Festival.

“We’re delighted to present these director-driven and audience engaging sales titles from around the world,” said Geoff Macnaughton, Senior Director, Industry & Theatrical. “As always, the industry will have a strong and healthy lineup of content to watch and add to their slates. As a major hub of sales activity, TIFF is the site of some of the industry’s most significant acquisitions each year.
