

At a meeting of both the AM and PM House of Representatives on Friay, December 5, Madison's outdated Constitution was revised. The presdents of all official classes in the main building and the annex voted by the required two-thirds vote to mend the Constitution by the adontion of the following requirements for andidacy in the student government

1. Students must have a general average of 80 per cent in order to be eligible to run for office.

2. Students must meet at least two of the following requirements:

a. Students must not have failed more than one major subject. b. Students must have served at

least one year as either official class officer, cabinet member, governor or Photo by Steve Campus lieutenant governor.

c. Students must have at least two major services to the school in addition to the aforementioned --- deemed satisfactory by the faculty advisers to those activities and the Commissioners of Elections.

The new amendments make more definite what the Election Board requires of the SGO aspirants.



What are research guides?

A research guide answers the question: What material does the Center for Brooklyn History have about ...? For example, many researchers ask: What material do you have about the history of my house? Answer: We have a research guide that summarizes the archival collections at CBH relating to housing and building research.

Do research guides include all the resources available at CBH on a particular subject?

No. Research guides typically focus on text-based archival material. CBH has many resources readily available to researchers in the Library & Archives — such as books, photographs, and maps — but these are not detailed in each guide. The research guides will provide suggestions about these other resources, but will not specifically identify them as they do for archival material.


