Over the past week, the contractor has working to resolve each of the issues we received over the last month. Here are the updates on their progress:

- The entire storage area has been reorganized, with some materials relocated and removed from Park Place.
- All unused cones and barriers have been removed.
- · Wood materials have been consolidated.
- Storage on Park Place has been reduced to one area at the corner of 250 Park Place, and this storage area has been pushed back.
- Storage in front of 254 Park Place has been reduced and materials have been removed.
- Removal of small storage areas in front of 299 Park Place and 286 Park Place restoring parking back to the community.
