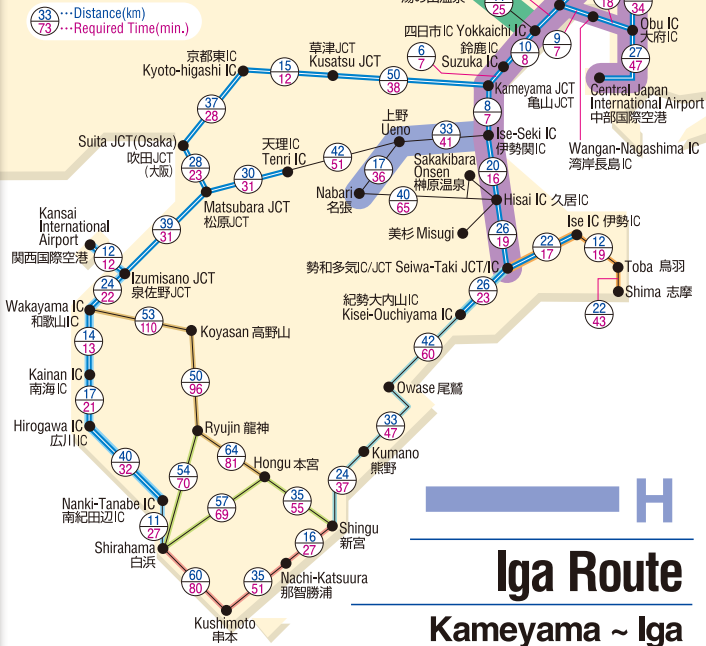
The attractions of this course heading north from Mie to Nagoya, are theme parks and urban areas.

In the winter, this place is famous for Japan's largest illumination display and in other seasons, for seasonal flowers: cherry, plum and cosmos.



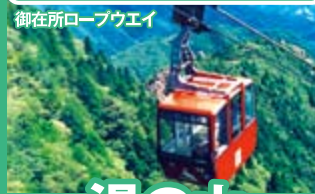
