Teneo tops matric results again

Dear Parent/Guardian

We're thrilled to share the exceptional achievements of Teneo's class of 2024.

Leading the way in academic excellence

1059 Teneo learners formed our sixth cohort of matriculants completing their 2024 NSC matric exams, achieving our highest pass rate ever, and taking the total number of Teneo learners who have obtained their National Senior Certificate (NSC) to over 3000 matriculants.

Teneo's SACAI pass rate has continued to improve, with Teneo learners achieving a pass rate of 82.18% which exceeded, by 8.28%, the national SACAI average of 73.9% for all online schools and distance education providers.

Our third and growing cohort of Grade 12 IEB learners also performed excellently with a pass rate of 85.2%.

Congratulations to Annika Terblanche (SACAI) and Ubuyisile Mtsweni (IEB) for being the top Teneo learners in 2024!

Top achievers - national

Annika Terblanche, a Teneo matriculant, earned the prestigious title of second-highest matriculant overall in South Africa through SACAI with 6 distinctions and an 88.71% average.

Teneo learner, Ulrich Kuschke was one of only 5 learners in SACAI with 7 or more distinctions. 4 of the 11 SACAI matriculants that achieved 6 distinctions were also from Teneo.

6 of the 16 national SACAI matriculants that achieved 6 or more distinctions were Teneo learners, outperforming all the other 58 institutions registered with SACAI, and further cementing Teneo's position as the leaders in academic excellence.

The top Teneo matriculant for the IEB curriculum was Ubuyisile Mtsweni, with 4 distinctions and an 84.71% average.

Top achievers - subjects

We are exceptionally proud of our learners who achieved top national subject placements:

- Annika Terblanche was awarded SACAI's best national performance in Mathematics with an average of 98% and placed second overall in the overall SACAI National Top 3.
- Kiara Knopfmacher was awarded SACAI's best national performance in English Home Language with an average of 85%.



High number of distinctions

In 2024, Teneo learners accounted for 14.8% of total SACAI distinctions, and 21.5% of the total SACAI matriculants who achieved university exemption.

27% of Teneo's matriculants achieved one or more subject distinctions in 2024.

Teneo learners achieved 410 subject distinctions, with 44 learners achieving three or more distinctions, and 94 learners achieved an aggregate of 70% or higher.

94.7% of Teneo's IEB learners and 89.2% of Teneo's SACAI learners achieved a Diploma Pass or higher, qualifying them for entrance to tertiary institutions.

Teneo learners consistently excel

For the 4th year in a row, Teneo learners placed in the SACAI national top 10 list.

Notably, Teneo students also placed 1st nationally in both 2021 and 2022, and in 2022, 3 Teneo learners were placed in SACAI's top 5 national learners.

British International curriculum global awards

Congratulations to 5 of Teneo's British International learners who between them received 6 prestigious Pearson Edexcel awards, competing against over 2200 learners across 750 schools in 82 countries!

- 2 learners achieved top marks in Africa in the International GCSE English Language exam - Olwami Shangase and Caitlyn de Klerk
- 3 International GCSE learners achieved top marks in South Africa: Mathematics exam - Tebogo Hlapo & Saoirse Thurgood; Biology exam - Jessica Godfrey; Chemistry exam Jessica Godfrey.

Learners in all grades thrive in 2024
