



## FEMINIST PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLIES (PMA<sup>1</sup>) MODEL

National Rollout | 2026–2027

Feminist People's Assemblies bring everyday women together to **define what their communities need and organize to win it**. This is how we rebuild democracy; we practice it.

Fifty years after the historic 1977 women's convention—and at the 250-year mark of this country—we step in as **the founding mothers** of what comes next, setting a **roadmap for the next 50 years and a vision for the next 250**.

**Trained facilitators** from the Houston convening will lead assemblies in every state. Each one feeds into a statewide and national feminist agenda, ratified at the 2027 Women's Convention.



## WHAT ASSEMBLIES PRODUCE

Each assembly builds a **community-rooted feminist agenda**—grounded in lived experience, not top-down policy.

Participants define:

- ★ A **vision** for a feminist future locally
- ★ **Priorities** shaped by real conditions
- ★ **Solutions** across policy, culture, and community
- ★ A **power map** (who must be moved)
- ★ Delegates empowered to **amend and vote to ratify** the national platform

Every assembly moves people into action.

# SHARED FRAMEWORK, LOCAL OWNERSHIP

Assemblies anchor in a shared feminist framework:

- ★ **Care Economy** (healthcare, childcare, elder care as rights)
- ★ **Bodily Autonomy** (reproductive justice, gender freedom)
- ★ **Safety & Freedom from Violence** (interpersonal, state, militarized)
- ★ **Democracy, Power & Sovereignty** (voting, representation, self-determination, war & peace)
- ★ **Economic Dignity** (wages, housing, debt, labor power)
- ★ **Movement & Belonging** (immigration, identity, inclusion)
- ★ **Technology & the Future** (AI, surveillance, digital rights, access, power)
- ★ **Land, Climate & Future Generations**
- ★ **Local Priorities** (defined by each community)

Facilitators use this as a starting point—not a ceiling.

## SCALING + VALIDATION

By Spring 2027, assemblies will operate in all 50 states.

As agendas take shape, Women's March activates its **8M-member base** to run statewide surveys, testing, refining, and validating priorities at scale.
