# COMPETITOR INFO MOUNTAIN BIKES ON SNOW CARDRONA ALPINE RESORT SUNDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER, 2025



### **EVENT DESCRIPTION**

As a summer mountain bike park why wouldn't Cardrona host a winter mountain bike race...on snow. Mountain bikes on snow is a mass start, first to the finish race from the top of McDougall's finishing at the resort base area beside the Chondola. Racers get a single practice run on the course before they line up for a mass start and race to the finish. Warm clothes, gloves, goggles, and full-body protection are recommended, and a full-face helmet is mandatory.

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The course starts beside the Whitestar Chairlift accessed from the Chondola. The course follows the gravity-cross course which is visible for spectators and racers as they ascend the chairlift. Racers must ride around the correct side of the triangle & rectangle gates. Anyone cutting the course will be disqualified. The race merges with Branch-line trail which returns racers to the base area and finish line.

#### **HOW TO ENTER**

Riders can enter on the day or pre-register online at www.cardrona.com/events.

Entry divisions: Open Men & Open Women (Junior added if interest)

Entry Fee: \$50 (includes 2 uplift passes for the Chondola)

\$30 for Season Pass holders

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION**

Competitor race plates can be collected from 8:30am - 9.30am on the competition day in the Slopeside ticket office on mountain (located through the red archway to the right - mountain side) All Mountain bikes **MUST** be cleaned prior to riding on snow. Bike scrutineering will be completed at registration. Bikes not fit for purpose will not be permitted to race. No studs, or spikes permitted. Must have disc brakes!

6.30am Snow reports online

8.30am - 9.30am Registration & scrutineering (Clean bikes outside patrol)

9:30am Race Briefing (outside Patrol)

9:30 - 10am Load bikes on McDougal's Chairlift

10:00am Course practice run; All competitors then load McDougals.

10:45am Men's Division Race Start

10.50am Women's Division Race start

11:am Awards ceremony at the finish line
