## **ENTRY AND LIFT PASSES**

Entries are to be completed through each school's sports department. The entry fee is \$45 per competitor. Lift tickets are available at an event rate of \$70 per day for competitors. The total schools entry fees & lift passes must be paid after submitting the entry form. A school can enter as many students as they like however only the top 3 results will determine the inter-school team results. All competitors can compete for individual podium places.

All schools should provide a team manager and a volunteer help during the event who will receive a complimentary day pass. ## **EVENT FORMAT**

The Banked Slalom (BSL) results are determined by the single fastest of 2 timed runs through the course. Competitors who miss a gate or go around the wrong side of the flag will be disqualified and will not receive a time for that run although they will get a 2<sup>nd</sup> chance as all competitors complete 2 timed runs. The Slopestyle event is a freestyle competition judged by a panel of 3 judges who assign scores based on variety.

difficulty and execution. Deductions are made for falls & faults. The single best score from the 2 runs will determine the slopestyle results.

#### **RESULTS AND AWARDS**

The Otago Southland Secondary School Awards ceremony will be held in the Cardrona Courtyard approximately an hour after the conclusion of the event. Competitors who place on the podium will be awarded medals. Mountain Aspiring college student's individual results will be presented at the school assembly.
