T-SKI GNARLOM SATURDAY 6TH SEPTEMBER 2025 TREBLE CONE SKI AREA



DESCRIPTION

The T-ski Gnarlom is set to become the iconic Treble Cone local skiers (only) off-Piste race. The Gnarlom concept was conceived by Sam "Ibex" Lee as an extreme alpine ski race incorporating jumps and drops and has evolved into an annual off-Piste Giant Slalom for advanced skiers.

RACE FORMAT

The course will be set the day prior to the race, and competitors can inspect the course before racing. On race day all competitors get to inspect (slow slip) then speed inspect the course prior to timed runs. Times from the 1st runs are ranked in each division with only the fastest (top 5) racers from each division advancing to the 2nd run/round.
