EVENT DESCRIPTION: Alpine Ski Masters racing is social and fun, and open to anyone 18 years and older. New for 2026 is the inclusion of an instructor division supported by the New Zealand Ski Instructors Alliance (NZSIA). The Wanaka Alpine Masters events include a Giant Slalom and Slalom at Cardrona Alpine Resort

RACE DISCIPLINES & FORMAT: Masters ski racing uses a handicap system which adds a factor or percentage to each racers raw race times based on their age. The handicap factor enables race times to be calculated for racers 18 – 80 years old. Raw times are displayed in the results however the handicap scores determine who steps onto the podium. Medals are awarded for Podium places and trophies are presented for combined overall handicap times. GS and Slalom training courses will be set on the race piste the day prior, so registered competitors can practice before the race.

HOW TO ENTER: *NZSIA members receive discounted entry and lifts*

Single discipline entry is \$50 | Single days racing \$90 | All Disciplines/days (2xGS +SL) \$140

To enter visit www.cardrona.com/events or enter at the Cardrona, Wanaka or Queenstown offices. Pre-registration is strongly recommended to speed up on the day bib collection & the race schedule. Lift tickets are available for seniors \$85 (65–74yrs), Adult \$135 (U65), +75yrs ski free.
