EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Treble Cone Banked Slalom is New Zealand's longest-running snowboard event and a great social catch up for all ages. For 2025 the race format will have qualifications scheduled on the Friday and finals on Saturday. A course will be set on Wednesday the 13th & we encourage competitors to get some practice runs in on the 13th and 14th! Both competition days will have the same format where competitors get 2 timed runs with the single fastest time determining who moves from qualifications to finals and then onto the podium. Previous Podium places can advance straight to the final day.

Pre-registration is available online or at any of Cardrona/TC ticket offices before midnight on Thursday 14th August. On the day entries will only be accepted before 9am and late entries may not be accepted. Please visit www.cardrona.com/events for info and entry.
