### **EVENT DESCRIPTION**

The Treble Cone Banked Slalom is New Zealand's longest-running snowboard event and a great social catch up for all ages. For 2025 the race format will have qualifications scheduled on the Friday and finals on Saturday. A course will be set on Wednesday the  $13^{th}$  & we encourage competitors to get some practice runs in on the  $13^{th}$  and  $14^{th}$ ! Both competition days will have the same format where competitors get 2 timed runs with the single fastest time determining who moves from qualifications to finals and then onto the podium. Previous Podium places can advance straight to the final day.

Pre-registration is available online or at any of Cardrona/TC ticket offices before midnight on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> August.
