HOW TO ENTER

Entry is \$125 and includes shuttles on race day but does not include chair lift access.

Saturday is a training only day with an optional track walk at the end of the day. The track walk is only accessible after the course closes at 3:30pm and no riding is permitted after this time.

Riders can purchase a training day competitor pass which will include shuttle laps and lift access for \$99, or if they have a season pass, they can purchase a competitor shuttle pass for \$70. This is for competitors only and can be purchased by emailing events@cardrona.com.

Age divisions are calculated as of the 31st of December. Male/Female age & entry divisions are as Masters (30+), Open, U19, U17, U15.
