ENTRY ELIGABILITY

To compete you must be confident riding downhill on strong blue to black trails and have a modern full suspension downhill or trail bike with disc-brakes. Competitors must be over 12 years of age and currently enrolled in a secondary school within the Otago and Southland regions. Home school students and students from outside the region can compete however they are not eligible for the team result (only Individual).

ENTRY & DIVISIONS

Entry is \$30, or \$70 which includes a day pass. Competitors require a lift pass to access the course. Competitors can register online or on the day before 9:30am. For all event info and to enter please visit: www.cardrona.com/events

DIVISIONS:

Boys | Junior (Y7-8), Intermediate (Y9-10), Senior (Y11-13). Girls | Junior (Y7-8), Intermediate (Y9-10), Senior (Y11-13).

Please note: Team results will be based off the best 3 race times combined.

RACE FORMAT

The course will consist of a technical Grade 5+ trail which will include a mix of flow and technical rocky sections. All riders will have 2 hours to practice on the course before completing up to 2 timed race runs. Riders who have a mechanical issue, a puncture, or who feel they can do a faster run can complete a 2nd run. The single fastest time will determine the individual race results. Combined times will determine the team results.
