EVENT DESCRIPTION

On the 5th September Cardrona are hosting a halfpipe event in the international (14ft) halfpipe with a focus on fun and progression. The event is a panel judged competition and part of the Snow Sports NZ Park and Pipe Series. Competitors enter the event via Snow Sports New Zealand.

SSNZ PARK & PIPE SERIES

The refreshed Snow Sports NZ National Park & Pipe Series brings together sanctioned events from across the country and gives up-and-coming freeski and snowboard athletes the opportunity to receive a national ranking. Athletes can earn points towards their ranking if they compete in three or more events during the season. To compete in the series, you must be a Snow Sports NZ member. If you aren't already a member, sign up here. Once you have signed up and have a membership number, you can register for individual events using the Snow Sports NZ event portal.

HOW TO ENTER

Enter online at Cardrona.com/events, or on the day at the Slopeside Guest services office on mountain (outside the Cardrona Archway). On the day and pre-registered competitors must collect a bib then head up to the bottom of the International Halfpipe, for a riders briefing. Entry is via the SSNZ Web site. Entries will close at 12pm 4th September.

EVENT FORMAT

(SSNZ Park & Pipe event) All riders get 40 minutes training followed by FIS international Halfpipe format and Judging. Judge criteria includes: Amplitude, Variety, Difficulty and Execution scored out of 100 points.

RESULTS AND AWARDS

Awards for Series 2 will be presented in the Cardrona Courtyard. Medals and prizes will be presented for podium places.
