## JetBlue launches its first Scottish route to New York.

JetBlue is on the way, so start spreading the news. The airline will operate daily flights between Edinburgh and New York JFK from May 23, marking its first ever Scottish route and offering up even more opportunity to see the bright lights of the Big Apple. Flights will operate on an A321 neo.

Toasting 20 years of connecting Edinburgh to the USA.

This year marks two decades of United's Edinburgh to New York Newark route - linking two of the world's great cities - and 20 years on it's still going strong as ever. The airline will also extend its service to Washington DC, with flights starting from March 31, providing more chances to visit one of the most iconic destinations in the US.

Flights will run until October 7, rather than finishing in early September. The airline will also continue to operate services to Boston and New York JFK, offering up a range of options for that trip to the States.

# Flying direct to Canada has never been easier.

A new route to Nova Scotia means passengers now have the option of direct flights to three fantastic Canadian cities - with opportunities to explore the east and west of the country.

WestJet will now operate flights to Halifax, along with Toronto and Calgary, while Air Canada will also fly direct to Toronto, ensuring plenty of choice for anyone planning an adventure for '24.





## Now fly to three Canadian cities with WestJet.

Exploring Canada has never been easier this summer with WestJet's direct service from Edinburgh to three Canadian cities. The airline is connecting Edinburgh to the city of Halifax, Nova Scotia for the first time, with flights operating three times weekly starting June 2024. WestJet is also offering up to daily flights to Toronto, Canada's largest metropolis, from May to October.

This summer, WestJet is increasing service between Edinburgh and Calgary, Alberta from three to four flights per week. Running from May through to October, this route will enhance travel from Scotland to the west of Canada and bring the natural beauty of the Rocky Mountains even closer.

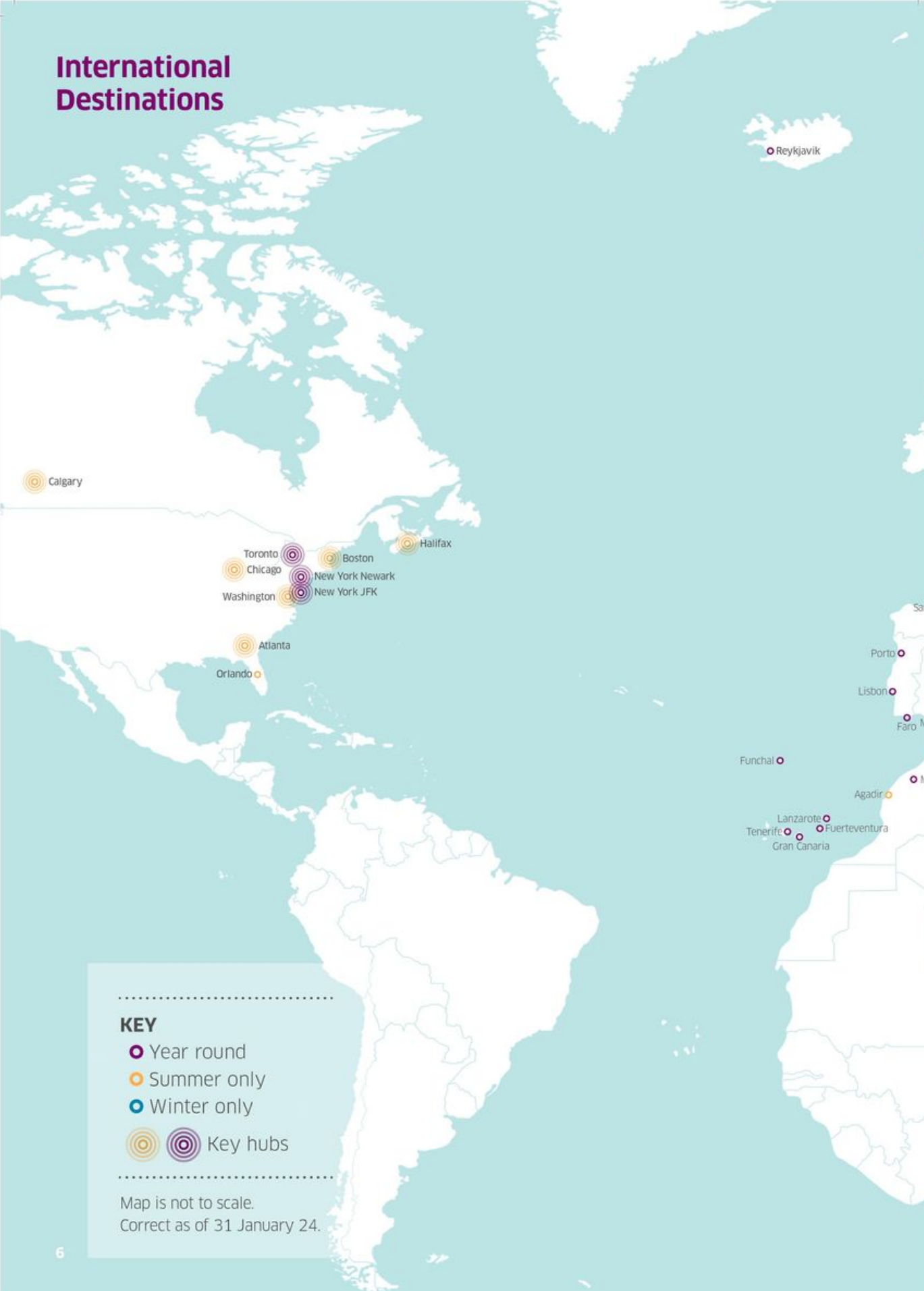


## Embrace three classes of comfort with Air Canada.

# More beaches, more cities.

In 2024, the addition of new European routes to cities in France, Italy, Spain, Germany, Norway and Morocco provide a wealth of opportunities for passengers. Jet2.com is enhancing its presence with a 7th based aircraft at the airport, while BA Cityflyer, Eurowings, SunExpress and Norwegian are among those adding new routes.

Ryanair will introduce several new Edinburgh routes this year as it expands its offering from Scotland's capital. Along with flights to the Moroccan city of Agadir it will begin operating services to Bergerac and Biarritz.
