

Chief Executive's Directive

CED 9/23 – Compulsory Training Re-Issue

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Date: 07th August 2023

This Directive replaces CED 01/23 which can now be destroyed.

The purpose of this Directive is to inform all partners operating at Edinburgh Airport of the **Compulsory Training** that must be completed before an airport ID pass can be issued to any new employee or any current employee requiring a re-issue pass.

General

All staff that hold an EDI pass must be given information, training and instruction on the following courses prior to an ID pass being issued.

It is the responsibility of each Partner to ensure their staff receive this training and provide recorded evidence using form (**Appendix A**) and present it to the ID Centre prior to passes being issued. Ramp Employees	Information
Aircraft Turnaround Video	<p>In addition to the general requirements to be authorised to operate airside at Edinburgh Airport, all Ground Handling Agent staff and persons <u>whose role brings them into contact with aircraft on stand</u> (those people who have an ID card that includes numbers 4, 5, 6 or 7) must complete this training. This includes Edinburgh based aircrew).</p> <p>15 min video showing the significant risk of operating close to live aircraft. Passenger movement control employees	Information
<p>In addition to the general requirements all staff who are responsible for controlling the movement of arriving/departing passengers must complete the following:</p>	
EDI Passenger Movement Training (theory only)	<p>In addition to the general requirements all staff who are responsible for controlling the movement of arriving/departing passengers must complete the following:</p> <p>1-hour theory training on controlling the movement of passengers at Edinburgh Airport. Must be delivered by Authorised Trainers using the approved programme.</p> <p>Currently authorised to deliver this training; Edinburgh Airport, Jet2.com, Menzies Aviation, Omniserve & Swissport</p>

Information:

In addition to the general requirements above all staff who routinely work on the airside ramp area, or control the movement of passengers, are required to receive other compulsory training courses before authorisation is given to perform certain operational tasks e.g. driving airside, operating loading bridges, controlling the movement of passengers. These are considered specialist tasks and need to be recorded by Partners and are subject to audit, but evidence is not required to obtain an ID Pass.
