### **Eligibility Requirements**

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, an applicant must either be a qualified Sheetz employee or the child/stepchild of a qualified Sheetz employee. A qualified Sheetz employee must have been in active employment and must have worked at least 320 hours (average 10 hours per week) from October 1, 2023 through May 10, 2024. Children/Stepchildren must be full-time, post-secondary students for the 2024-2025 academic year. Employee applicants may be full-time or part-time students (earning no less than 12 credit hours per academic year). Part time student applicants are eligible for a \$5,000 Scholarship.
