TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering the Competition, each entrant confirms that they have read, understood and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. A copy of these Terms and Conditions will be made available on the Competition landing page throughout the Competition Period.

Competition Period	Opens: 12:00 UTC on 20 July 2026. Closes: 16:25 BST on 25 July 2026, or, if the race window for the Event is rescheduled, at the time five (5) minutes before the scheduled start of the first race as notified by SailGP. Entries received outside this period will not be accepted.
Eligible Entrants	Open to individuals aged 18 years or over at the time of entry who are natural persons and legal residents of any country or territory in which the Competition is lawfully made available by the Promoter through the Competition landing page, excluding any Excluded Territories listed below. Persons who are resident in any Excluded Territories (if applicable) are not eligible to enter the Competition.
Excluded Territories (if any)	Excluded Territories means any country or territory where participation in the Competition, the offering or receipt of the Prize, or any related promotional activity is prohibited or restricted by law, requires registration, licensing, approval or other regulatory steps which the Promoter has not taken, or would otherwise be unlawful or contrary to any applicable sanctions, export control, gambling, trade promotion or consumer protection laws. At the date of these Terms and Conditions, the Promoter does not intend to make the Competition available in any Excluded Territories.
Entry Method	Visit https://sailgp.com/general/competition/portsmouth-predictor-correctly-guess-to-p-four-25k/ and complete and submit the online entry form hosted by Riddle, the Promoter's competition service provider, by providing your first name, last name and email address before the Closing Date. Alternatively, you may enter via Meta instant forms made available as part of the Promoter's paid media campaign by submitting your first name, last name and email address before the Closing Date.

	To enter, you must predict and submit the top four teams in finishing order for the Event using the entry form on the Competition web page (hosted by Riddle) or via the Meta instant forms. No purchase or payment is required to enter or win.
Winner Selection Method	Only entries that correctly predict the top four teams in the correct finishing order for the Event (based on the official final standings published by SailGP) will be eligible to win the Prize. If there is a single eligible entry with a correct prediction, that entrant will be the winner. If there are multiple eligible entries with correct predictions, one (1) winner will be selected at random from those eligible entries using a computer-generated randomisation process determined by the Promoter. If no eligible entry correctly predicts the top four teams in the correct finishing order, the Promoter reserves the right not to award the Prize.
Winner Selection Date	27th July 2026
Winner Notification Method	The winner will be contacted using the email address provided on entry within five (5) business days of Winner Selection Date. The winner is responsible for ensuring that the contact details provided on entry are accurate and remain in use; the Promoter will not be responsible if it is unable to contact the winner due to incorrect or outdated information supplied by the winner.
Prize Claim Period	The winner must respond to the Promoter's notification and confirm acceptance of the Prize within five (5) calendar days of the date of the notification and provide any information reasonably requested by the Promoter to verify eligibility, including proof that the winner is aged 18 years or over. If the winner fails to do so, cannot be contacted, refuses the Prize, or is otherwise found to be ineligible, the Promoter may, in its sole discretion, withdraw the Prize and select an alternative winner from the remaining eligible entries in accordance with the Winner Selection Method.
Prize	One (1) prize consisting of a cash amount of twenty-five thousand US dollars (USD \$25,000) (the "Prize"). The Prize will be paid to the winner by electronic bank transfer to a bank account in the winner's name, or by such other secure payment method as the Promoter may reasonably determine, within thirty (30) days after the winner has provided valid payment details and successfully completed any verification checks required by the Promoter. Should the winner request payment in a currency other than US dollars, the Promoter shall arrange such payment. In that case, the amount received in the winner's chosen currency will depend on the applicable exchange rate and any fees at the time of conversion and transfer, and the Promoter will not be responsible for any exchange-rate fluctuations or bank or payment-provider charges. The winner is solely responsible for any taxes, duties, charges or other costs arising in connection with the receipt of the Prize and the Promoter may withhold such amounts as it is required to withhold by law.

Part B – Standard Terms and Conditions

1. Application of these Terms

- 1.1. These Standard Terms and Conditions along with the Competition Details Schedule above (together, the "**Terms and Conditions**") govern the Competition.
- 1.2. In the event of any inconsistency between the Competition Details Schedule and these Standard Terms and Conditions, the Competition Details Schedule shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.
- 1.3. Capitalised terms have the meanings set out in the Competition Details Schedule.
- 1.4. Entrants are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions upon submitting a valid entry into the Competition.

2. Promoter

- 2.1. Unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule, the Promoter of the Competition is F50 League LLC, a Delaware limited liability company with its principal place of business at 368 9th Avenue, New York, NY 10001, USA.

3. Competition Period

- 3.1. The Competition will run for the duration of the Competition Period.
- 3.2. Entries received outside the Competition Period will not be accepted.
- 3.3. The Promoter's timekeeping systems shall determine all dates and times relating to the Competition.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1. The Competition is only open to Eligible Entrants.
- 4.2. Unless otherwise specified in the Competition Details Schedule:
 - 4.2.1.** entrants must be at least eighteen (18) years of age at the time of entry;
 - 4.2.2.** entrants must be natural persons acting in their own name;
 - 4.2.3.** employees, officers, directors, contractors and agents of the Promoter, SailGP teams, SailGP entities, sponsors, prize providers and their immediate family members or members of the same household are not eligible to enter.
- 4.3. The Promoter reserves the right to verify eligibility at any time and may require proof of identity, age, residency or any other information reasonably necessary to confirm eligibility. If an entrant fails to provide such information within a reasonable time of request, the Promoter may, in its sole discretion, disqualify the entrant from the Competition.
- 4.4. The Competition is void where prohibited or restricted by law.
- 4.5. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse or disqualify entries where participation, prize fulfilment or continued participation in the Competition would breach applicable laws or regulatory requirements.

- 4.6. The Promoter may carry out sanctions, anti-money laundering and other compliance checks in relation to entrants and the winner. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry to, or withhold or withdraw the Prize from, any person where it reasonably believes that awarding the Prize or allowing participation would breach applicable sanctions, export control, anti-money laundering, gambling, trade promotion or consumer protection laws.

5. Entry

- 5.1. Entrants must enter the Competition using the Entry Method.
- 5.2. Unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule:
- 5.2.1. no purchase, payment or other consideration is necessary to enter or win;
 - 5.2.2. only one (1) entry per person and per email address is permitted; and
 - 5.2.3. entries must be submitted personally by the entrant and not through agents or third parties acting on the entrant's behalf.
- 5.3. Proof of submission is not proof of receipt.
- 5.4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, incomplete, corrupted, illegible or otherwise incapable of being processed for reasons beyond its reasonable control, including technical failures of networks, hardware, software, websites, platforms or service providers.
- 5.5. Entries that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions may, at the Promoter's discretion, be deemed invalid and ineligible to win the Prize(s), without an obligation on the Promoter to notify the entrant.

6. Entry Restrictions and Conduct

- 6.1. Unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule, multiple entries beyond the permitted limit are prohibited.
- 6.2. The Promoter may reject, remove or disqualify any entry that:
- 6.2.1. is incomplete, illegible, altered, reconstructed, forged or misleading;
 - 6.2.2. is generated by script, macro, bot, automated means or other method designed to circumvent the entry process;
 - 6.2.3. uses multiple identities, email addresses, accounts, devices, IP addresses or other methods to circumvent entry limits;
 - 6.2.4. breaches these Terms and Conditions; or
 - 6.2.5. otherwise gives rise to reasonable suspicion of fraud, dishonesty or unfair conduct or behaviour that is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Competition or may bring the Promoter into disrepute.

7. Winner Selection

- 7.1. Each winner will be selected using the Winner Selection Method.

- 7.2. Where the Competition involves a random draw, the winner(s) will be selected randomly from all eligible entries validly received during the Competition Period, using a fair and verifiable process reasonably determined by the Promoter.
- 7.3. Where the Competition involves prediction, judging or another assessment-based mechanic, only entrants who satisfy the applicable winning criteria set out in the Winner Selection Method will be eligible to win.
- 7.4. If more than one eligible entrant satisfies the relevant winning criteria:
 - 7.4.1. and there are multiple Prizes available for the same winning criteria, the Promoter will select the applicable number of winners, one per Prize, at random from among those eligible entrants (and, if Prizes are tiered but not distinguished by different winning criteria, the tiering of the applicable winners shall likewise be determined randomly); or
 - 7.4.2. if there is only a single Prize available for the winning criteria, the Promoter may either:
 - 7.4.2.1. select one winner at random from those eligible entrants; or
 - 7.4.2.2. apply any tie-break mechanism stated in the Competition Details Schedule.
- 7.5. Where the Competition outcome depends upon the result of a SailGP event, all Competition outcomes shall be determined solely by reference to the official final standings published by SailGP, including any amendments resulting from protests, penalties, appeals, abandonments, ties or other official revisions, unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule.
- 7.6. Subject to applicable law, the Promoter's decisions on the administration of the Competition, winner selection and Prize fulfilment shall be final and binding.

8. Winner Notification and Claim

- 8.1. Each winner will be notified using the Winner Notification Method.
- 8.2. The winner must respond and complete any verification or prize-acceptance steps required by the Promoter within the Prize Claim Period.
- 8.3. The Promoter may require the winner to verify their identity, age (confirming that the winner is 18 years or over), eligibility and compliance with these Terms and Conditions before awarding the Prize.
- 8.4. If a winner cannot be contacted, fails to respond within the Prize Claim Period, refuses or is unable to accept the Prize(s), fails verification or is otherwise disqualified, that winner will be deemed to have forfeited the Prize(s) and the Promoter may withdraw the Prize and select an alternative eligible winner in accordance with the Winner Selection Method or a reasonable replacement process.

9. Prize Terms

- 9.1. The Prize(s) (as applicable) are the sole prize(s) made available to the winner(s) of the Competition.
- 9.2. Unless expressly stated otherwise in the Competition Details Schedule:
 - 9.2.1. each Prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable and non-refundable;
 - 9.2.2. no cash alternative is available;
 - 9.2.3. no Prize may be sold, auctioned or used for any commercial or promotional purpose without the Promoter's prior written consent; and

- 9.2.4. the Promoter reserves the right to substitute a Prize, or any part of it, with a prize of equal or greater value where it considers it reasonably necessary (including, without limitation, where the original Prize(s) or any element of it is unavailable, withdrawn, delayed, disrupted or impracticable to provide).
- 9.3. Any costs, charges, taxes (including any income, withholding or similar taxes), duties, fees or expenses associated with a Prize and not expressly stated as included in the Competition Details Schedule shall be the sole responsibility of the applicable winner.
- 9.4. Unless expressly stated otherwise, any cash element of a Prize is stated as a gross amount, and the Promoter shall have no responsibility for any taxes payable by the winner in connection with receipt or use of the Prize.

10. Travel Prize Terms

- 10.1. This clause 10 applies only where a Prize includes travel, accommodation or a similar travel-related benefit.
- 10.2. Unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule:
- 10.2.1.** the winner and any guest are responsible for obtaining valid passports, visas, travel insurance, health documentation and any other documentation required for travel or attendance;
 - 10.2.2.** the winner and any guest must comply with all carrier, venue, destination and governmental requirements;
 - 10.2.3.** travel arrangements, airlines, accommodation providers, room types, ticket allocations and similar logistics will be determined by the Promoter or the relevant Prize provider;
 - 10.2.4.** the winner and any guest must travel together on the same itinerary unless the Promoter agrees otherwise in writing; and
 - 10.2.5.** the Promoter is not responsible if the winner or any guest is unable to take the Prize because of visa, passport, health, personal or regulatory reasons.
- 10.3. Entrants should ensure they are available to travel on the dates specified for the applicable Prize in the Competition Details Schedule before entering the Competition.
- 10.4. Unless stated otherwise in the Competition Details Schedule, the Prize(s) do not include travel insurance, meals, personal expenses, local travel (including airport transfers) baggage fees, visa or entry application fees, or any other incidental costs, which are the sole responsibility of the winner and any guest.
- 10.5. If the winner or any guest is unable or unwilling to travel on the dates specified for the applicable Prize, the Promoter is under no obligation to provide an alternative prize or cash equivalent and may, at its discretion, treat the Prize as forfeited and select an alternative winner.

11. Experiential Prize Terms

- 11.1. This clause 11 applies only where a Prize includes an experience, activity or participation element.
- 11.2. Unless otherwise stated in the Competition Details Schedule, participation in any experience is subject to availability, weather, venue rules, operational requirements, safety requirements and any instructions given by the Promoter, venue operator, event organiser or Prize provider.

- 11.3. The winner and any guest may be required to sign waivers, releases, indemnities, medical questionnaires, safety acknowledgments or other documents before participating.
- 11.4. The Promoter, venue operator, event organiser or Prize provider may refuse participation by any person where reasonably necessary for health, safety, conduct, security, operational or legal reasons.
- 11.5. Tickets and access to Promoter events, hospitality areas and experiences forming part of the Prize are subject to the standard [ticketing terms and conditions](#) of the Promoter (in its capacity as event organiser), the relevant venue and any ticketing provider. Entrants acknowledge and agree that attendance at any SailGP event and use of any tickets or hospitality benefits is conditional upon compliance with those terms and conditions, including any health, safety and behavioural requirements.
- 11.6. The Promoter may withdraw, amend, substitute, reschedule or cancel any experiential element of the Prize where reasonably necessary and no compensation will be payable for any removed or unavailable element except to the extent required by applicable law.

12. Publicity

- 12.1. The Promoter may request that each winner participates in reasonable publicity, promotional activities and marketing relating to the Competition, the Prize, SailGP, the Promoter and its affiliated companies.
- 12.2. Unless otherwise required by applicable law, participation in such publicity is voluntary. Where applicable law requires the winner's consent, the Promoter will obtain such consent before using the winner's personal data for publicity purposes.
- 12.3. Where the winner agrees to participate in publicity, the Promoter may use the winner's name, image, likeness, photograph, voice, statements and any Competition-related content for reasonable promotional, publicity and marketing purposes connected with the Competition, the Prize, SailGP and related events, in any media now known or developed in the future, including on SailGP websites, social media channels, digital platforms, broadcast media, press releases and other marketing materials, in each case in accordance with applicable law and any consent obtained.
- 12.4. The Promoter may use such publicity materials in connection with the Competition, future competitions, promotions and events organised by the Promoter or its affiliated companies, SailGP events and championships generally and the promotion of the Promoter's and its affiliated companies' businesses, products and services.
- 12.5. Any processing of the winner's personal data for publicity purposes shall be carried out in accordance with applicable data protection laws and the [SailGP Privacy Policy](#). Where consent forms the legal basis for such processing, the winner may withdraw that consent at any time, although this will not affect the lawfulness of any use made before consent was withdrawn.
- 12.6. Following the administration of the Prize, and in accordance with applicable advertising regulation, the Promoter may be required to publish or make available information indicating that a valid award took place, such as the winner's surname and country, county, province, state or region of residence and, where applicable, their winning entry. At or before the time of entry, entrants will be informed of this requirement and given the opportunity to object to, or request a reduction in, the amount of information published or made available. Even if the winner objects, the Promoter may still be required to provide this information, together with any winning entry, to the relevant advertising regulator on request. The privacy of prize-winners will be respected and any publication of personal data will be carried out in accordance with applicable data protection laws and the [SailGP Privacy Policy](#).

13. Personal Data

- 13.1. For the purposes of applicable data protection laws, the Promoter acts as a controller of the entrants' personal data in connection with the Competition.
- 13.2. The Promoter will process entrants' personal data (including names, contact details and any other personal data submitted in connection with the Competition) for the purposes of administering the Competition, verifying eligibility, selecting and contacting winners, awarding and administering the Prize, complying with legal and regulatory obligations and otherwise operating the Competition.
- 13.3. By entering the Competition, entrants acknowledge that they may receive marketing and promotional communications from the Promoter and its affiliated companies in accordance with the [SailGP Privacy Policy](#) and applicable law. Entrants may unsubscribe from marketing communications at any time using the unsubscribe link included in such communications or by otherwise contacting the Promoter. Unsubscribing from marketing communications will not affect an entrant's participation in the Competition or any future eligibility, except where continued communications are necessary for the administration of the Competition or fulfilment of the Prize(s).
- 13.4. The Promoter will process personal data where necessary for the performance and administration of the Competition, to comply with its legal obligations and, where appropriate, for its legitimate business interests in operating, promoting and improving the Competition and its business. Where required by applicable law, the Promoter will obtain the entrant's consent before processing personal data for specific purposes.
- 13.5. The Promoter may share entrants' personal data with its affiliated companies within the SailGP group, sponsors, prize providers and event organisers involved in the Competition, third-party service providers engaged to administer the Competition or fulfil the Prize and competent regulatory authorities or other third parties where required by law or to establish, exercise or defend legal claims, but only to the extent reasonably necessary for those purposes.
- 13.6. As SailGP operates internationally, personal data may be transferred to countries outside the entrant's country of residence. Where such transfers occur, the Promoter will implement appropriate safeguards in accordance with applicable data protection laws.
- 13.7. Personal data will be retained only for as long as reasonably necessary to administer the Competition, award and fulfil the Prize, comply with legal or regulatory obligations, resolve disputes or enforce these Terms and Conditions.
- 13.8. Entrants may have rights under applicable data protection laws, including rights to request access to, correction or deletion of their personal data, to object to or restrict certain processing, to request data portability and, where processing is based on consent, to withdraw that consent at any time.
- 13.9. Further information about how the Promoter collects, uses and protects personal data, and how entrants may exercise their rights, is available in the [SailGP Privacy Policy](#).
- 13.10. Entrants in the United Kingdom have the right to lodge a complaint with the UK Information Commissioner's Office (www.ico.org.uk) if they consider that their personal data has been processed unlawfully, without prejudice to any other rights they may have.

14. Fraud and Misconduct

- 14.1. The Promoter reserves the right to verify entries and disqualify any entrant who:
- 14.1.1.** submits multiple entries where not permitted by the Competition Details Schedule;
 - 14.1.2.** provides false or misleading information;
 - 14.1.3.** tampers with the entry process;
 - 14.1.4.** uses automated entry methods or bots;
 - 14.1.5.** acts fraudulently or dishonestly; or
 - 14.1.6.** seeks to gain an unfair advantage; or

14.1.7. otherwise breaches these Terms and Conditions.

15. Amendment, Suspension and Cancellation

15.1. The Promoter reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions, suspend, modify or cancel the Competition or disqualify entries where reasonably necessary due to fraud, technical failures, legal or regulatory issues, force majeure, health and safety issues or circumstances beyond the Promoter's reasonable control.

16. Competition Website

16.1. The Competition website and any associated applications are provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis.

16.2. The Promoter does not warrant that any Competition website or application will be uninterrupted, secure or error-free.

16.3. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter accepts no responsibility for technical failures affecting entry into the Competition.

16.4. Entrants are responsible for ensuring they have appropriate systems and security measures when accessing Competition websites.

16.5. Entrants are responsible for taking appropriate precautions to protect their own devices, software and data when accessing the Competition website or any associated applications.

16.6. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for viruses, malware or other harmful material transmitted through the Competition website except where liability cannot lawfully be excluded.

16.7. Access to the Competition may be provided via third-party platforms or services (including without limitation Riddle and Meta). The Promoter is not responsible for any acts or omissions of such third parties, or for any unavailability, interruption or malfunction of their platforms or services, except where liability cannot lawfully be excluded. Entrants are solely responsible for complying with any applicable terms and conditions of those third-party platforms or services.

17. Liability

17.1. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes or limits any liability that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited, including liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation or any other liability which cannot be excluded by applicable law.

17.2. Subject to clause 17.1, the Promoter shall not be liable for any indirect, consequential or unforeseeable loss arising out of or in connection with the Competition or the acceptance, use or misuse of the Prize.

17.3. Subject to clause 17.1, the Promoter shall not be responsible for:

17.3.1. any failure to receive an entry;

17.3.2. any inability to claim or use the Prize due to personal circumstances, documentation issues, travel restrictions or third-party acts or omissions; or

17.3.3. any cancellation, delay, rescheduling or unavailability affecting any element of the Prize or any related travel or experience beyond the Promoter's reasonable control.

18. General

- 18.1. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
- 18.2. The Promoter's failure to enforce any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
- 18.3. These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the entrant and the Promoter in relation to the Competition.
- 18.4. These Terms and Conditions and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them shall be governed by English law, except to the extent that mandatory consumer protection laws in the entrant's country of residence apply.
- 18.5. The courts of England and Wales shall have jurisdiction over any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with these Terms and Conditions, except where an entrant is entitled under applicable mandatory consumer laws to bring proceedings in the courts of their country of residence.
