

### Introduction

The R1T Tire Lift Harness makes it easier to remove the spare tire from the truck bed and to replace it after use. It includes a cover, removal strap, and four handles.

To clean the R1T Tire Lift Harness, wipe it down with a damp cloth to remove any dirt or debris.


## Install the Tire Lift Harness the First Time

- 1. Remove the Tire Lift Harness from the packaging.
- 2. Lay the cover on the ground, loosen the straps all the way, and unhook the clips.
- 3. Place the wheel onto the cover with the rim face down.

### **NOTE**

The cover doesn't need to be perfectly centered.


4. Pull the cover up the sides evenly, all the way around the diameter.




5. Hook the clips.



6. Tighten the straps.



- 7. The cover should fit tightly and evenly around the tire with the straps firmly fastened.
- 8. See Return the Tire to the Spare Tire Compartment (page 7) for instructions on returning it to the spare tire compartment.

# Remove the Tire from the Spare Tire Compartment with the Lift Harness

Here's how to remove the spare tire from the spare tire compartment in the truck bed.

- 1. Open the tailgate.
- 2. Lift the release lever to open the spare tire compartment.
- 3. Push the compartment lid to a vertical position.
- 4. Unfasten the spare tire wing nut and remove the tire service kit from the spare tire.
- 5. Use the hex hole on the spare tire wing nut to unscrew and remove the tire service kit retention rod. Save the wing nut and retention rod for reinstallation.
- 6. From the rear of the vehicle, grab the spare tire cover's handle and stretch it out over the tailgate.
- 7. While braced against the tailgate, pull the spare tire cover's handle to lift the front edge of the tire out of the spare tire compartment.
- 8. When the tire is at a 45-degree angle, reach forward and grab the two handles on the lifted front edge of the spare tire cover.
- 9. Pull the cover handle to remove the spare wheel from the spare tire compartment and onto the tailgate.
- 10. Pull the tire to the edge of the tailgate and drop it to the ground.
- 11. Undo the tension straps on the top of the cover to loosen the cover.
- 12. Lift the tire to a vertical position and remove the cover.

## Return the Tire to the Spare Tire Compartment

- 1. Perform the instructions in Install the Tire Lift Harness the First Time (page 5).
- 2. Using two people and the four handles around the edges of the lift harness, lift the covered tire onto the tailgate.



### **CAUTION**

The tire is heavy.

- 3. Position the covered tire to center the Lift Harness handle toward the rear of the vehicle.
- 4. Toss the Tire Lift Harness handle fully onto the spare tire.
- 5. Push and slide the tire from the tailgate into the spare tire compartment.



#### CAUTION

The tire may slide into the spare tire compartment suddenly. Be careful not to pinch your fingers.

- 6. Replace the tire service kit retention rod through the wheel hub center and tighten it with the wing nut.
- 7. Replace the service kit on the retention rod.
- 8. Secure the wing nut to the retention rod.
- 9. Close the bin lid. Be sure to engage both latches.
- 10. Close the tailgate.
