


CAUTION

- · Don't use for lifting or towing.
- · Always secure cargo properly before driving.
- · Don't throw the cargo net.
- Don't leave it on the ground where it can potentially be damaged.
- · Don't twist or knot the webbing.
- Don't overload the capacity of the net by using mechanical aids (levers, bars, or cheater bars).

Install the R1T Cargo Net

The R1T Cargo Net safely secures items in the cargo storage area, preventing them from sliding or rolling during transport. It comes in a Rivian branded storage bag along with four carabiners attached with straps and cam buckles.



Item	Description
1	Rivian Storage Bag
2	R1T Cargo Net
3	Carabiners (straps and cam buckles)

- 1. Inspect the R1T Cargo Net webbing for signs of dirt, wear, or disrepair.
- 2. Load cargo into the R1T truck bed.




CAUTION

Check the R1T weight limits before placing cargo into the truck bed. Don't exceed the suggested R1T payload capacity of 1,500 lbs (680 kgs).


- 3. Ensure that the cargo is balanced and stable in the bed of the R1T.
- 4. Optionally, you can place a protective sleeve or blanket over the cargo to protect the R1T Cargo Net from friction, abrasion, or sharp edges.



5. Lay the R1T Cargo Net over the top of the cargo.




6. Attach the carabiners to the eyelets on the corners of the R1T Cargo Net.







7. Attach the carabiners to the cargo tie-down rings along the edges of the R1T truck bed.



8. Pull the straps tightly to secure the cargo.



- 9. Tuck in excess netting to provide a tight fit around the cargo.
- 10. Ensure that the straps are equally tensioned on all sides of the cargo.



Remove the R1T Cargo Net

- 1. Ensure that the cargo is stable before attempting to remove the net.
- 2. Carefully unclip the carabiners from the cargo tie-down rings.
- 3. Remove the net from over the cargo.
- 4. Inspect for signs of dirt, wear, or disrepair.
- 5. Fold it and place it in the storage bag.



DANGER

Unstable cargo may fall when removing the R1T Cargo Net and pose a danger to the user.

Maintain the R1T Cargo Net

You can perform the following care and maintenance actions to extend the life of your R1T Cargo Net.

Storage

- · Keep the net clean and dry.
- · Always use the provided storage bag.

Cleaning

- · Wash oil, fuel, or acid off immediately using hot, soapy water.
- · Rinse alkali with cold water (before alkali dries).
- · Don't heat or apply heat treatment.

· During use, avoid

- · Throwing the net.
- · Leaving the net on the ground where damage can occur.
- Twisting or knotting the webbing.
- Exceeding the recommended force when tightening the straps.
- Overloading the capacity of the net with mechanical aids like levers or bars.

Routine Maintenance

- Inspect for signs of wear, twisting, or stretching before and after every use.
- · Discontinue use if you find any signs of wear.
- · Clearly mark any faults or signs of wear.
