

First responder - Quick guide

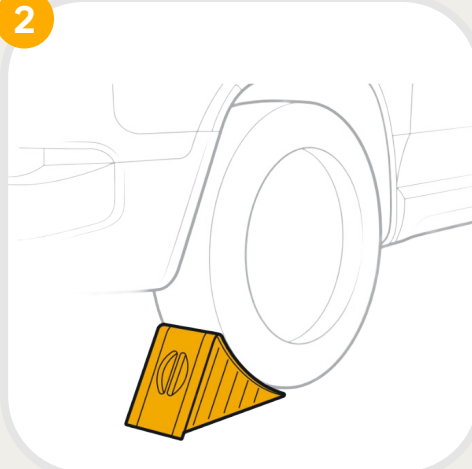

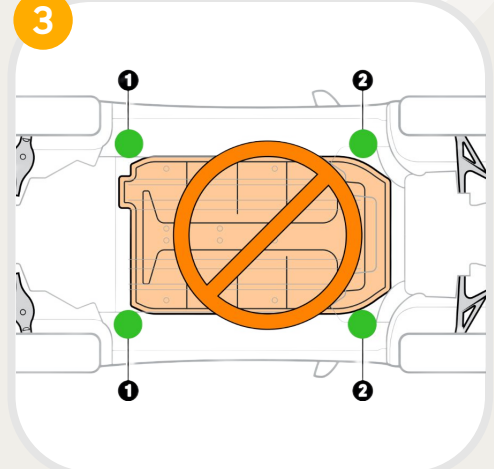
Always wear insulated rubber gloves.

Secure the vehicle with wheel chocks/cribbing.

3



Only lift from the designated lifting points (green circles).

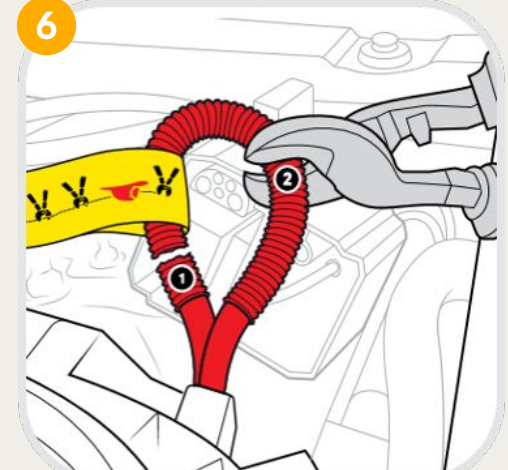
Open the hood (avoid cutting near the charge port).

5



Locate the cutout loop near the windshield on the driver's side.

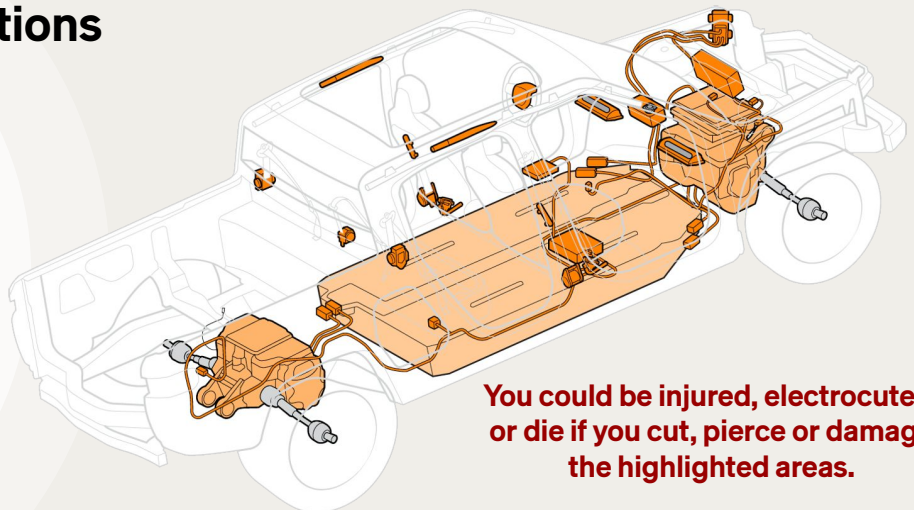

Cut the loop in two places and remove the cut section.

Important notes & precautions

1. Do not cut the loop if the vehicle is on fire, submerged, or shows signs of potential fire.
2. Use a thermal imaging or infrared camera to locate fires and elevated temperatures.
3. If using a ram, do not use the floor of the vehicle inward of the sills.
4. Use a hydraulic cutter or reciprocating saw with a diamond blade to cut the high-strength steel around the doors.



You could be injured, electrocuted, or die if you cut, pierce or damage the highlighted areas.

Always use a flatbed to transport a disabled Rivian. If necessary, puncture all 4 tires to prevent a towing service from towing a Rivian with wheels on the ground.
