

## Safety Statements



#### DANGER

Use the power bank only in a dry location. Exposure to moisture or liquids may cause electric shock or fire.



#### DANGER

Keep the power bank away from high heat sources and fire.



#### WARNING

- To charge the power bank, use only the charging compartment on the driver-side door of a Rivian vehicle or a USB-C cable with a compatible power adapter.
- Don't use the power bank if there is any damage to it, the USB-C cable, or the power adapter.

#### IMPORTANT

The rechargeable battery isn't replaceable. When the battery can no longer hold a charge, follow local regulations for the disposal of household hazardous waste.

## **About the Power Bank**

### NOTE

The Power Bank can be used as a hand warmer, as well as to charge a device using its USB-C connection. It can be charged in the driver-side door compartment, or by using a USB-C cable connected to a power source.

## **Use the Power Bank**

### **Power Bank Mode**


The power bank has a USB-C connection that can be used to charge another device.

### Hand Warmer Mode

The power bank can be used as a hand warmer by single-pressing the **Heat** button (2) to cycle through the heat levels.

#### NOTE

The hand warmer mode can't be used if the power bank is charging a device or being charged.



State	Action	LED Behavior	LED Status
Max heat	While hand warmer is off, press (2) for maximum heat	Second and third LEDs are solidly lit	$\bigcirc \bullet \bullet \bigcirc$
Low heat	While hand warmer is on maximum heat, press (2) for low heat	Second LED is solidly lit	$\circ \bullet \circ \circ$
Off	While hand warmer is on low heat, press (2) to turn off hand warmer	All LEDs are off	0000

## **Charge the Power Bank**

### **Charge in Door Compartment**

The power bank can be charged when inserted into the driver-side door compartment.



#### CAUTION

If the power bank is in the charging compartment, ensure that the power bank is completely seated before closing the driver-side door. If you close the door while the power bank sticks out, this may damage the door, door frame, or power bank.

- 1. Insert the power bank in the charging compartment of the driver-side door. Ensure that the end with the USB-C port is facing outside.
- 2. Press firmly until it clicks into place.

#### NOTE


To release the power bank from the charging compartment, press firmly until the power bank pops out.



### **Charge with USB-C**

The power bank can be charged using a cable that attaches to its USB-C port.

- 1. Connect the USB-C end of the cable to the power bank.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to a power outlet.






The following table shows the charging options and what the LED lights indicate.

State	LED Behavior	LED Status
<ul> <li>USB-C cord is inserted into power bank USB-C port</li> <li>Power bank is being docked in vehicle door compartment</li> </ul>	LEDs flash in sequence	
<ul> <li>Power bank is being charged by USB-C</li> <li>Power bank is being charged in vehicle door compartment</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>LEDs blink the percentage that's being charged</li> <li>LEDs stay solid when a corresponding percentage completes charging</li> </ul>	
Power bank is charging a device by USB-C	<ul> <li>LEDs display battery level as solidly lit percentage</li> <li>LEDs turn off after 5 seconds</li> </ul>	

### **Battery Check**

Check the battery level by single-pressing the **Battery** button (1).



State	LED Behavior	LED Status
<ul> <li>Power bank is off</li> <li>Power bank is charging a device</li> <li>Power bank is in hand warmer mode</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>LEDs flash in sequence</li> <li>LEDs display battery level</li> <li>LEDs time out after 1.5 seconds</li> </ul>	
Power bank is in low battery mode	LEDs blink twice	
Power bank is charging	No action	0000

## **Clean the Power Bank**

Maintain the power bank by occasionally cleaning it with a damp cloth.



### DANGER

- Before cleaning, unplug the power bank from the power outlet to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Don't use compressed air to clean the power bank.
