In October 2022, Sam Harper (pictured on the left), a dedicated advocate and PXE International Board Member, embarked on a meaningful bike journey from St. Augustine, Florida, to Peapack, New Jersey, alongside his friend Mike (pictured on the right), showcasing their commitment to raising awareness for PXE. Unexpectedly, their heartfelt journey was shortened when Sam's twin brother Charlie, also living with PXE, fell critically ill and sadly passed away.

With their 2022 journey cut short, Sam and Mike set out this week where they left off in Wilmington, North Carolina, and plan to complete the route they started!

Mike acts as Sam's eyes on the road. Sam can follow his line and taillight while Mike calls out any obstacles that Sam might not be able to see. This cooperation has enabled them to bike through 16

states, and they are hoping to reach 25 states by the end of this trip. Their goal is to bike through all 50 states!

This ride is not their first rodeo. Starting in 2017, Sam and Mike have done numerous rides and **have raised over \$58,000 for PXE.**
