## Overnight lane closures to cause detours for some drivers heading to McCarran International this evening

Road construction near McCarran International will require workers to close some northbound access roads leading to the airport from 7 p.m. today through approximately 5 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 8. \*

Drivers seeking to access Passenger Pick-Up, Zero Level or McCarran's employee garage by way of the Airport Connector Tunnel or Russell Road will be redirected toward westbound Tropicana Avenue. (See attached map.)

From Tropicana, drivers can turn left onto southbound Paradise Road, which leads back toward the airport. Electronic message boards and roadside flaggers will be present to help redirect traffic.

Southbound access to McCarran will not be affected by this overnight work, which includes paving and milling portions of the northbound access roadways, as well as the installation of new overhead directional signage.

\* Editor's Note: A decision to prolong this detour by one additional evening could be made overnight tonight if inclement weather prevents workers from installing new road surfaces as scheduled. Should that occur, the same detours would be in effect from 7 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 8, through 5 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 9.

Traffic approaching Zero Level, Passenger Pick-Up or the employee garage from Russell Road must first travel north to westbound Tropicana Avenue, then turn left onto southbound Paradise Road. Overnight road closure Northbound tunnel traffic headed to Zero Level, Passenger Pick-Up or the employee garage must first proceed to westbound Tropicana Avenue, then turn left onto southbound Paradise.
