## McCarran introduces its New Economy Lot There's plenty of room to park at the airport over the holidays, though drivers are advised that lots' locations have changed

LAS VEGAS – McCarran International this week unwrapped a long-awaited gift that should greatly benefit locals who travel during the upcoming holiday season. The airport's new 5,100-space Economy Lot is open for business, and McCarran customers are encouraged to make it their first stop when flying out of town for Thanksgiving or any other traveling occasion.

"When it comes to parking, we've seen a lot of changes at McCarran over the past couple of years," said Randall H. Walker, director of the Clark County Department of Aviation. "The introduction of our new Economy Lot is a significant step toward meeting the airport's long-term parking needs, and we're excited to have it in service in time for what's historically been a popular time of year for Southern Nevadans to travel."

McCarran's new Economy Lot is located just south of Tropicana Avenue on the west side of Paradise Road. Drivers using southbound Paradise can access the lot by turning right (west) onto Kitty Hawk Way or Gus Guiffre Drive. Those heading to McCarran by way of the Airport Connector Tunnel should follow the posted directional signs leading to the new Economy Lot. (See attached map).

Economy Lot patrons pay a maximum of \$8 per day for uncovered parking. McCarran's Long Term garage (up to \$14 per day) and Valet parking (up to \$21 per day) are also options, though those sites often fill quickly during busy travel periods such as Thanksgiving. The airport's new Remote Lot, located along Gilespie Street between Warm Springs Road and the Las Vegas Beltway, is also available at a maximum rate of \$5 per day.

Shuttles run continuously between McCarran's uncovered parking areas and terminals. Drivers using these lots should set aside at least 30 additional minutes to move to or from the airport.

Domestic travelers are asked to arrive at McCarran approximately 90 minutes before their scheduled departure time. The Department of Aviation projects more than 686,000 travelers will pass through McCarran from Wednesday, Nov. 26 through Monday, Dec. 1. Crowds will peak Nov. 26 and Sunday, Nov. 30.

Short Term parking and the passenger pick-up curb will also be busy.
