'Tis the Season to Travel Smart: Key Tips for a Joyful Journey Through LAS!

Like Santa and his elves, LAS is BUSY:

- **Plan Ahead:** Arrive at the airport at least two hours before your scheduled departure. If you're parking at the airport, allow even more time.
- **Expect Traffic:** Be prepared for delays on airport roadways, especially at the departures curb and passenger pickup.
- **Checkpoint Prep:** Familiarize yourself with the latest security policies at www.tsa.gov. You can also reach out via X to @AskTSA or on Facebook Messenger at fb.com/AskTSA.
- **Food and Beverage Demand:** With more travelers, expect longer wait times for dining options. For information on concession availability, hours, and locations, visit www.HarryReidAirport.com/Relax.

Need to Park Your Sleigh?

- Parking is in high demand: Airport parking facilities will reach capacity at times, including the Terminal 1 Long Term Garage and the Terminal 3 Economy Lot. When full, you'll be redirected to available facilities (posted rates apply).
- Best Parking Options:
 - Head straight to the Terminal 3 Long Term Garage.
 - If traveling without checked bags, proceed through the TSA Security Checkpoint at T3 and access your departure gate via tram.
- If checking bags at T1, use the courtesy shuttle located on Level Zero of both terminals, running approximately every 15 minutes.
- Parking Reservations: LAS launched a pilot parking reservation program last month. This new service enables
 travelers to reserve airport parking, saving travelers time and making their trip more convenient. Reservations can
 be scheduled at parking harryreidairport.com.
 - Availability:
 - Terminal 1 / Level 2M 286 spaces at \$28/day
 - Terminal 3 / Level 1 350 spaces at \$21/day
- Overflow Economy Lot: If the Terminal 1 Economy Lot is full, you may be redirected to an overflow lot at 576 Kitty Hawk Way. Allow an extra 30 minutes for shuttle service.
- Remote Lot: Additional parking is available at the Remote Lot across from the Airport Rent-A-Car Center at 7140 Gilespie Street. Allow an extra 30 minutes for shuttle service.


Holiday Travel Tips:

- **Gifts:** While wrapped gifts aren't prohibited, it's best to wait until you reach your destination to wrap them or use gift bags, as security may need to unwrap items for inspection.
- **Weather:** Weather conditions throughout the country can impact flights everywhere. Be prepared for potential delays by keeping essentials such as snacks, medications, and chargers. .
- **Airline Policies:** Each airline has different rules, including baggage fees and seat selection charges. Be sure to familiarize yourself with your airline's policies ahead of time.

- **Security:** Generally, only ticketed passengers can pass through security. If you need to meet an unaccompanied minor or assist a traveler with special needs, visit your airline's ticket counter for authorization and allow for extra time.
- Remote Bag Drop: Avoid potential lines at airline ticket counters by checking bags and printing boarding passes at either of the remote bag drop locations. The Airport Rent-A-Car Center bag drop is open from 4 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Thursdays through Mondays. Terminal 3 Departures bag drop is open from 4 a.m. to Noon, Thursdays through Mondays.

Reduce Roadway Congestion for Pick Up:

- **Cell Phone Lot:** Instead of circling the airport, wait at the free Cell Phone Lot off Kitty Hawk Way, open daily from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.
- Easier Meetups: Look for numbered columns when picking up passengers.
- **No Curb Parking:** Curb parking is prohibited. If your party isn't ready, pull into Short Term parking, where the first 15 minutes are free. Use the exit lane reader to claim your free minutes.
