RESIDENTS INVITED TO OPEN HOUSE AT HENDERSON EXECUTIVE AIRPORT

Neighborhood residents are invited to attend an open house at Henderson Executive Airport on **Monday, July 24** from **5:00 to 7:00 p.m.**, located at 3500 Executive Terminal Drive, Suite 100. The open house is an opportunity for the residents who surround the airport, generally in the Anthem and Seven Hills area, to view the property, tour the new facilities and ask questions to Department of Aviation staff. In 1996, the Clark County Department of Aviation purchased Henderson Executive Airport, formerly named Sky Harbor.

While failing to meet even minimum aviation standards, the airport, with its convenient location in the fast-growing community of Henderson and close proximity to McCarran International Airport, demonstrated potential as a premier general aviation airport. Residents will notice the difference between the old and new airport.

The two parallel runways were built in a particular way to keep aircrafts away from residential homes as much as possible. In addition, the Clark County Department of Aviation continues to work with both the city of Henderson and adjacent developers to reduce noise impacts over all sensitive residential areas through established noise abatement procedures.

The facility was designed and constructed with the neighborhood in mind and has an aesthetically pleasing look. The new terminal is 24,000-square feet and its amenities include a modern flight planning facility, free Wi-Fi, conference rooms, a pilots' lounge with flat screen satellite television and private dressing rooms and showers. A restaurant and pilot shop will also be located within the facility in the near future.
