AIRPORT TRAVEL TIPS

One carry-on plus one small personal item. Carry-on Policy will be enforced.

- Do not lock your bags. Both carry-on and checked bags are subject to search.
- Pack undeveloped film in carry-on bags. Checked baggage screening equipment will damage film.
- Arrive early. Allow 2 hours before your flight.
- Bring your ticket or printed E-Ticket confirmation. If you have only carry-on: go directly to the gate.
- Bring valid photo identification to show upon check-in.
- Call ahead. Call your airline to ensure flight information is correct and that the flight is on time.
- Pack smart, and tag all bags both inside and out.
- *Ticketed Passengers Only may go to the gate areas.* To meet unaccompanied minors or assist disabled passengers, go to the ticket counter first for written authorization.

AIRPORT PARKING For parking information call 261-5121.

- All vehicles are subject to search.
- Short-term metered parking. (3 hours or less) is available in the airport garage. Follow the signs and Yellow arrows to "Short Term or Passenger Pick Up." Cost: 25 cents per 10-minute period. Additional short-term metered parking is located on Level 2M. Follow the red roadway triangles up the ramp. Additional signs direct drivers toward the Level 2M entrance. From there, customers will take the elevator to Level 1 for Passenger Pickup.
- Long-term parking. \$3 for the first hour, and \$10/day maximum. Follow the Green arrows.
- Valet Parking is available. \$4 for the first hour, and \$14/day maximum.
- **Remote Parking Lot** on Russell Road at Kelly Lane will open when the garage is full. Signage will direct drivers to the Remote Lot. \$2 for the first hour, and an \$8/day maximum.
