McCarran Prepares For Fourth of July Weekend

Passengers Should Arrive Early

The Fourth of July is a busy travel holiday and this year will be no exception at McCarran International Airport. **Travelers are reminded to arrive early at the airport to accommodate for parking, checking-in at the ticket counter and passing through the security checkpoint.** Travelers should call the airline in advance to confirm the flight and find out how early to arrive at the airport.

McCarran has serviced more than 16.8 million passengers through May and passenger counts are expected to grow over the summer months. Due to the heavy volume, spaces in the long-term parking garage may not be readily available. However as traffic demands, the remote parking lot located at the intersection of Russell Road and Kelly Lane will be open seven days a week, 24-hours a day, at a cost of \$8.00 per vehicle per day. An airport courtesy shuttle will take customers to and from the terminal.

To ensure your personal safety and maintain quality passenger service, the following are travel tips for airport passengers:

- Passengers are not allowed to carry fireworks in their bags or on their person on commercial flights. A firework of any
 kind is considered a banned explosive. Passengers may be fined as much as \$30,000 per violation and up to five years in
 prison.
- Be prepared to show a valid photo identification.
- Passengers are allowed one carry-on and one personal item. Personal items include laptops, purses, backpacks, briefcases, diaper bags or camera cases.
- Do not lock your bags as carry-on and checked luggage are subject to search.
- Do not pack or bring prohibited items to McCarran International Airport. For a complete list visit the Transportation Security Administration website at www.tsa.gov
- Only ticketed passengers will be allowed to go to the gate area. To meet unaccompanied minors or assist disabled passengers, go to the airline ticket counter first for written approval.

McCarran Parking:

- All vehicles are subject to search.
- **Short-term** metered parking, three hours or less, is available on Level 1 and 2M of the airport garage at a cost of 25 cents per 10-minute period.
- Long-term parking is located in the parking garage at a cost of \$3 the first hour and a maximum of \$10 per day.
- Valet parking is available in the parking garage on Level 2 at cost of \$4 the first hour and a maximum of \$14 per day.
